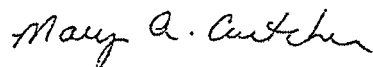

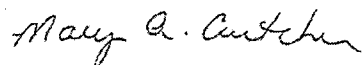
After the break the next song was *Since Jesus Came Into My Heart*. Resolution committee report is as follows:
