

Minutes of the Northern Quarterly

The Northern Quarterly met in regular session July 14, 2018 at Olivet Free Will Baptist in Clarksville, TN. We joined together in the fellowship hall for breakfast. Rev. Dwayne James welcomed the assembly and thanked Rev. Chris Camp for hosting. Rev. Chris Camp gave thanks for allowing Olivet FWB to host and gave instructions for today's meeting. Rev. The business session began with the seating of the ordained ministers, ordained deacons, and delegates. Visitors were recognized.

Rev. Todd Parrish gave a report on behalf of Welch College. He thanked the NQ for all of their support. It has been a great year at Welch, they have had a 33 year high record in enrollment and a record in giving. They graduated 56 students this past Spring. Rev. Eddie Hodges brought greetings and thanks from FWB Family Ministries. The Youngs home has 33 children in it the year. They also have received a gift of \$400,000 to build an activity center in Arkansas. They are hoping this time next year there will be a maternity home open to house pregnant women. Please pray for their search for a new director as Bro. Frank Woods has stepped down. Please continue pray for Family Ministries.

Rev. Stan Coker asked that the body continue to keep praying for the camp. There have been some trials, but there have also been some amazing things going on at the camp. They are continuing growth at the camp. This year they had 633 campers. Every week has had over 100 campers. They have also had several groups come in. They are receiving support for the new flex-cabins and zipline. Rev. Coker gave continued thanks to the NQ Meeting.

Rev. Chad Kivette came and gave a brief report on behalf of PVCS. Things are going well. They have hired Brandon Roysden. Rev. Kivette also gave a brief report on behalf of E-team. He encouraged people to send their kids to E-team and/or Truth & Peace. He also shared how influential the Northern Quarterly itself can be to our own children. Rev. Kivette shared about his family's future plans to go plant a church in Sevierville. Please be praying for them and if you are able to host them they would greatly appreciate it.

Sis. Margaret Hampton shared about their current board consisting of five members. Over 100 competitors will be going to Nationals this year in 65 categories. March 1st and 2nd will be next year's district. On August 23rd the board will be hosting an informative meeting at New Hope at 6:30. All NQ churches are encouraged to send a representative to learn more about CTS. She also thanked Rev. Phillip Morgan for all his years of service to the CTS board.
