

#### A BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE ORGANIZATION OF THE

#### RANDALL ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS

Because of the size of the General Conference and the great distance necessary to travel to attend its meetings, the Conference peaceably voted Nov. 10, 1972 to divide and to form two Associations. Churches belonging to the western half would belong to one of the associations, and those belonging to the eastern half would be members of the other. Any General Conference Church could be a member of either association.

A meeting of the ministers of the western half of the General Conference was held at the Garner Free Will Baptist Church Feb. 20, 1973 to examine a proposed constitution and by-laws for the new association. At least 18 ministers were present. Another meeting will be held at the Garner Free Will Baptist Church March 31, 1973 to organize the new association.

The organizational meeting of the new association convened at the Garner Free Will Baptist Church March 31, 1973. Rev. Ronald Niebreggue was was elected Moderator; Rev. Dean Dobbs, Assistant Moderator; Rev. Ralph Osborne, Clerk; and Rev. Grant Saverance, Treasurer. The body voted to call itself the Randall Association. A motion passed that the Constitution be received, and to vote on its adaption at the September meeting.

The General Conference met May 26, 1973 at Faith Free Will Baptist Church in Goldsboro. It voted to dissolve in order for the western half to become the Randall Association and the eastern half the Palmer Association. Immediately following this meeting Rev. Bill Robinson was elected Moderator Pro Tem, as Rev. Niebreggue was leaving the state.

At the meeting of the State Association at Faith Free Will Baptist Church, Goldsboro, June 12, 1973, the Randall Association was received as a member of the State Association and its ministers and delegates were seated.

MINUTES OF THE RANDALL ASSOCIATION held with the PROSPECT FREE WILL BAPTIST CHURCH, March 16, 1974

Services began by singing "Leaning On the Everlasting Arms", led by Rev. Dennis Lowry.

Prayer by Rev. John S. Craft.

Congregational singing of "Glory to His Name".

Devotions were conducted by Brother Billy Blackman, using Luke 18:9-14.

Welcome was given by the moderator, Rev. Bill Robinson.

Clerk read roll of churches.

Clerk read roll of licensed and ordained ministers.

At this time our Moderator, Bro. Robinson recognized the delegates from our churches and our ministers. He also recognized our visitors and extended a hardy welcome.

The moderator recognized Rev. James Stepps, State Home Missionary, who spoke about the work in Siler City.

Rev. Charles Keith gave a report for Rev. Ronald Creech concerning the Book Store in Durham.

The Constitution and By-laws of the Randall Association were given to the churches (three each).

The association addurned for recess from 10:35-10:45.

After the recess, Rev. Lowry lead in congregational singing of "My Savior's Love". Rev. Lonnie Graves led in prayer. The Young Ladies Trio of the Prospect Church sang, "It's In Your Hand." A worship offering was received. Rev. Robinson introduced Rev. Randy Cox, after which the Young Ladies Trio of the Prospect Church sang, "If That Isn't Love".

Rev. Randy Cox preached, using Acts 2:41-5:42, on the subject "The First Church."

The Association was dismissed for recess and the noonday meal by Rev. Charles Keith.

Afternoon session began at 1:00 P.M. by congregational singing, "At Calvary." Prayer by Brother Joe McLamb.

Minutes of September, 1973 meeting were read as information.

Treasurer's report was given by Bro. Lee Thomas. (See report No. 4) Motion passed to adopt the Treasurer's report.

(Moderator told to have minutes of the September, 1973 and March, 1974 Meetings printed.) Motion passed that 100 minutes be printed in mimeograph form. Rev. Lonnie Graves said he would have this work done.

Rev. Nathan Eason gave the Digest Committee's report. (See report No. 3) An amendment was offered to accept the invitation of the Hilltop Church for the Randall Association Meeting in September, 1974.

Motion was made and seconded to accept the report and vote on the recommendation. The recommendation lost and motion to hold the next session with the First Church, Sanford, carried.

The Resolution Committee gave its report. Motion passed to adopt the report. (See report No. 6)

The recommendation of the Finance Committee was given. Motion passed to receive the recommendation. (See report No. 5) A discussion was held concerning reimbursing board members 15¢ per mile on travel expences for associational business. A substitute motion was offered that the clerk and the chairman of the various boards study this matter and report to the next meeting. Motion carried.

Motion was made to donate \$200.00 to the Promotional Department of the State Association. Motion carried.

Moderator recognized Rev. L. D. Creech who said we should keep enough money in the Association for our expenses.

Motion passed that \$100.00 be given to Siler City work.

Report of the Board of Missions was given as information.

Report of the Board of Ministerial Standing was given. (See report No. 8) Recommended that: Rev. Randy Cox, Dennis Lowry, and James Stepps be received into the Randall Association. Motion passed that they be received.

Board of Youth report given orally by Bro. Lawrence Tart as information.

Motion by Rev. Lonnie Graves that Acticle II, Section I, be amended by stricking out the words "The Original" and insert at the end of "Baptists" these words "as adopted by the National Association of Free Will Baptists." Motion passed. Motion passed that a copy of the Constitution and By-laws be sent to each Church and Preacher of this Association.

The Nomination Committee gave its report.
(See report No. 7) Motion passed to elect Bro.
Kermit Turner to the Mission Board, taking the place of Bro. Owen Thomas. Rev. Mathan Eason was elected Moderator, replacing Rev. Bill Robinson who has moved.
Rev. Eason resigned from the Board of Ministeral Standing. Rev. Dennis Lowry was elected to the Board of Ministeral Standing.

Motion passed that a rising vote of thanks be given Bro. Bill Robinson for his interest and work with us. The clerk read a lett
