

The visitors were welcomed.

Rev. Gene Outland expressed thanks to the McLambs of Prospect Free Will Baptist Church in Dunn for their gift to our Bible College of more than \$100,000. He then presented them with a lifetime membership to our Free Will Baptist BibleCollege Alumni Association.

Rev. Ronald Creech told about our North Carolina projects. He pointed out that some of our churches no longer support the state work because they do not know enough about it. He challenged us to encourage our churches to support the work.

Rav. Guy Owens mentioned that it might be good to have the 1977 National Association meeting in North Carolina. Present plans are to have it in Detroit Michigan, but there have been city problems there. It may not be safe unless something changes.

Ne dismissed for a recess at 10:45 a.m. and mat back at 11:00 a.m.
