

RNADALL ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST SEPTEMBER 15, 1978 LIBERTY FREE WILL BAPTIST CHURCH DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA

The meeting was opened at 7:30 P.M. by singing, "Crown Him with many Crowns" led by Brother David Thomas. Opening prayer was by Rev. Bronco West. The Moderator read Scripture from Hebrews 10 emphasizing verses 19-25.

Committees were appointed to prepare the various items needing attention. The service was turned over to the host pastor, Rev. Bill Gardner, who introduced the musical grogram presented by the choir of Liberty Church and individual arrangements.

Following the program Brother Sam Truett reported on the summer youth camp. There were 47 teens and 86 juniors with several being saved and many other decisions made. Camp was held at Eagles Nest and a great time was had both weeks.

An offering was received, then the minuted of the March 17, 1977 Associational meeting were read and approved. Brother Gene Outland made a report for the Youth Board:

We endeavored to provide a variety of programs for the young people on a monthly basis during the past year. We did not have meetings during the summer months. We are trusting to have some great programs during the coming months which we trust will provide a ministry and blessing for our juniors and teens.

The Board of Ministerial Standing made the following report: We recommend that:

(1) A letter of recommendation to the Cumberland Association be sent for Bro. Ronald Creech.

(2) Brother Richard Barnes be accepted into our association as a licensed minister. (The Board expresses its apology to Bro. Barnes for not meeting with him at our last meeting.)

(3) Brother Mike McAuly be accepted into our

association as an ordained minister.

- (4) The name of George Ray be dropped from our roll of ordained ministers and the First Free Will Baptist Church of Roxboro be dropped from our roll of churches. Both church and pastor have withdrawn from the Free Will Baptist Denomination and have renounced F.W.B. doctrine. And that he be notified in same manner as Lonnie Graves.
- (5) Brother Donnie Miles be accepted into our association as an ordained minister pending receipt of a letter of recommendation from the Coastal Association of N.C.
- (6) That Brother Bruce Barnes be received into our association as an ordained minister.

Bobby Smith and was not passed.

Several announcements followed concerning activities and revivals. An invitation from Bro. Bronco West, pastor of the Fellowship F.W.B. Church, Dunn for the March, 1979 Randall Association was promptly accepted.

Motion, seconded, carried to give the host church a vote of thanks and to adjourn. Refreshments were then served. Closing prayer by Carl McCabe.

The meeting was opened by singing, "Trust and Obey" led by Rev. J. M. Creech. Opening prayer by Rev. Gene Cutland. The Moderator, Rev. John Craft, welcomed everyone to the meeting and read Scripture from John 1. Bro. Johnny Allen and his wife favored us with a duet, "Lovest Thou Me?"

The service was turned over to our speaker, Rev. Bobby Smith. His Scripture was found in Revelation chapters 2 and 3 using Revelation 3:1 as a starting text. Bro. Smith brought a challenging message using the seven churches in these chapters as a basis. Following the message an offering was received.

We have been encouraged with the increase in interest concerning cur youth work and we are anticipating some great things from the Lord as we plan for future meetings and activities.

Brother Sam Truett announced a Missions Youth Rally on April 28 and Youth Camp weeks scheduled are June 18-23 for Teen Week and June 25-30 for Junior Week. He expressed the need for lifeguards for both weeks. Rev. Gene Outland made a motion to receive the entire youth report. It was seconded and carried.

Rev. Guy Owens, Minister-At-Large, made a brief report concerning his ministry to our North Carolina churches. A challenge was given concerning the responsibility of the Randall Association toward helping the other North Carolina associations host the National Association this summer in Charlotte. Appreciation was expressed for the regular support of our churches to the Office of Minister-At-Large. Motion, seconded, carried to receive this report as information.

Brother Jack Forlines reported that a Randall Association of Master's Men has been organized. He challenged other churches to begin a Master's Men program and join the fellowship. Motion, seconded, carried to receive this report as information.

The Board of Ministerial Standing recommends that Richard Barnes be received into the Randall Association as an ordained minister. Motion, seconded, carried to receive him.

Brother Barnes expressed God's blessings upon the Sanford work with attendance in the fifties. The report was received by a unanimous voce.

Brother Guy Owens submitted his resignation as a member of the Board of Ministerial Standing due to his responsibilities as Minister-at-large. Rev. Nathan Eason was elected to fill this position by a unanimous vote after a Motion by Bro. Guy Owens to elect him.

Brother Bobby Smith reported to us concerning Senate Bill 383, PRIVATE CHURCH SCHOOLS, which separates our fundamental Christian Schools from other private schools and from unnecessary State control. Motion, Rev. Bobby Smith, that we go on record as supporting Senate Bill 383, PRIVATE CHURCH SCHOOLS, and that a letter expressing this action be sent to each member of the House of Representatives of North Carolina. The motion was discussed and carried by a unanimous vote.

Rev. Randy Cox suggested we list the counties in which we have churches that are members of the Randall Association in the letter. He stated that ladies from this church would place this information to each Representative personally.
