

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE SALEM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS OF FLORIDA

PREAMBLE

WE, THE BELIEVERS IN CHRIST ACCORDING TO THE DOCTRINES OF THE FREE WILL BAPTIST DENOMINATION, HAVING BEEN BAPTIZED INTO A LIKE PROFES-SION OF FAITH IN JESUS CHRIST AND PROPERLY ORGANIZED INTO CHURCHES, REALIZING THE NECESSITY OF A BOND OF UNION AND FELLOWSHIP AMONG US FOR PRESERVATION OF THE "FAITH ONCE DELIVERED UNTO THE SAINTS" AND THE SPREADING OF THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST UPON EARTH, DO THEREFORE ORDAIN AND ESTABLISH THIS CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE I - NAM E

, e.,

THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE SALEM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS OF FLORIDA.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE TO UNIFY THE WORK OF THE CHURCHES COMPOSING THIS ASSOCIATION BY DEVISING AND EXECUTING SUCH MEASURES AS WILL SPREAD THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST AS WE INTERPRET IT.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

ANY REGULARLY AND ORGANIZED AND WELL DISCIPLINED FREE WILL BAP-TIST CHURCH CONFORMING TO THE USAGE'S OF THE FREE WILL BAPTIST DE-NOMINATION AS SET FORTH IN THE TREATISE OF THE FAITH AND PRACTICES OF THE FREE WILL BAPTIST OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION MAY UPON PROP-ER APPLICATION AND A VOICE OF THE ASSOCIATION, BECOME A MEMBER OF THIS ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE IV - COMPOSITION

THE SESSIONS OF THE ASSOCIATION SHALL CONSIST OF THE DELEGATES AP-POINTED OR ELECTED BY THE CHURCHES OF WHICH THIS ASSOCIATION IS COMPOSED. ALL ORDAINED MINISTERS AND DEACONS WHO ARE MEMBERS AND IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE ASSOCIATION AND THE CHURCHES TO WHICH THEY BELONG, SHALL BE STANDING DELEGATES. MINISTERS FROM SISTER ASSOCIATIONS WHO ARE SERVING CHURCHES IN THE ASSOCIATION SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE SUGGESTIONS BUT THE VOTING RIGHTS SHALL BE RESERVED FOR THE DELEGATES OF THE SALEM ASSOCIATION. ALL OFFICERS OF THE ASSOCIATION SHALL BE STANDING DELEGATES.

ARTICLE V-REPRESENTATION

EACH CHURCH IN THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ONE DELEGATE FOR EVERY 25 MEMBERS OR FRACTION THEREOF.

ARTICLE VI-OFFICERS, BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND REPRESENTATIVES

THE PURPOSE OF EACH BOARD IS TO PROMOTE ITSELF DOMESTICALLY AND INTERNATIONALLY WITHIN THE SALEM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS BIBLICALLY, ETHICALLY AND MORALLY TO FORMULATE AND PROMOTE A LIVELY PROGRAM BY THE AIDING OF OUR CHURCHES. THE ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW CHURCHES AND BY AN EARNEST EFFORT TO KEEP A SPIRIT OF REVIVAL PRESENT IN THIS ASSOCIATION. SECTION 1. THE OFFICERS OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE A MODERATOR, A VICE-MODERATOR, A CLERK/TREASURER AND AN ASST. CLERK/TREASURER, WHO SHALL BE ELECTED EVERY 2 YEARS ON THE ODD YEAR, EXCEPT TO FILL VACANCIES, SECTION 2. THE STANDING BOARDS OF THIS ASSOCIA-TION SHALL BE THE EXECUTIVE BOARD, MISSIONS BOARD, YOUTH BOARD AND CHRISTIAN EDUCATION BOARD. SECTION 3. THE COMMITTEES OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEES, RESOLU-TIONS, FINANCE, NOMINATIONS AND OBITUARIES. SECTION 4. REPRESEN-TATIVES: 1. THE ASSOCIATION SHALL ELECT 2 LAYPERSON TO SERVE ON THE CAMP MT. PLEASANT BOARD OF DIRECTORS, 1 MEMBER ELECTED EACH YEAR TO SERVE 2 YEAR TERMS. 2. THE ASSOCIATION SHALL NOMINATE 1 PERSON ANNUALLY TO REPRESENT THE ASSOCIATION TO THE FLORIDA STATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE VII-BOARDS

SECTION 1. THE EXECUTIVE BOARD SHALL BE COMPOSED OF THE OFFICERS OF THE ASSOCIATION, THE CHAIRPERSON OF EACH STANDING BOARD AND ONE REPRESENTATIVE AT LARGE FROM EACH CHURCH. SECTION 2. MISSION BOARD SHALL BE COMPOSED OF 5 MEMBERS ELECTED ANNUALLY ON A RO-TATION BASIS, THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL BE ELECTED ANNUALLY. SECTION 3. YOUTH BOARD SHALL BE COMPOSED OF 3 MEMBERS ELECTED AN-NUALLY ON A ROTATION BASIS, THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL BE ELECTED AN-NUALLY. SECTION 4. CHRISTIAN EDUCATION SHALL BE COMPOSED OF 3 MEMBERS ELECTED ON A ROTATION BASIS, THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL BE ELECTED ANNUALLY.

ARTICLE VIII-COMMITTEES

THE COMMITTEES OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE APPOINTED ANNUALLY. A. COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEES WILL BE COMPOSED OF 3 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE MODERATOR, TO RECOMMEND THE PERSONS TO FILL THE REGULAR COMMITTEES OF THE ASSOCIATION. B. REGULAR COMMITTEES ARE: RESOLUTIONS-COMPOSED OF 3 MEMBERS NOMINATIONS- COMPOSED OF 3 MEMBERS FINANCE-COMPOSED OF 3 MEMBERS AND OBITUARIES COMPOSED OF 1 MEMBER.

ARTICLE IX-SESSIONS

THE SESSIONS OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE HELD QUARTERLY. THE SPRING AND FALL SESSIONS WILL CONVENE ON FRIDAY NIGHT BEFORE THE (2ND) SATURDAY IN APRIL AND OCTOBER. THE SUMMER SESSION WILL CON-VENE ON THE (2ND) SATURDAY IN JULY AND THE WINTER SESSION, WHICH IS OUR ANNUAL SESSION, WILL CONVENE ON FRIDAY NIGHT BEFORE THE (2ND) AND ON THE 2ND SATURDAY IN JANUARY. ANNUAL LETTERS AND REPORTS SHALL BE RECEIVED IN THIS SESSION.

ARTICLE X-FINANCE

SECTION 1. ALL CHURCHES REPRESENTED IN THIS BODY ARE ASKED TO PAY \$75.00 QUARTERLY OR \$300.00 ANNUALLY FOR STATE REPRESENTATIVE FEES. SECTION 2. EACH CHURCH IS ASKED TO SEND AT LEAST 10% OF IT'S INCOME FOR THE COOPERATIVE PLAN OF SUPPORT. SECTION 3. ALL COOPERATIVE FUNDS COMING INTO THIS BODY SHALL BE SPENT UNDER BUDGET PLAN. THE BUDGET MUST BE APPROVED BY THE BODY WHILE IN SESSION. SECTION 4. THE MODERATOR AND CLERK/TREASURER SHALL RECEIVE \$50.00 ANNUALLY FOR THEIR SERVICES. THE CLERK/TREASURER MAY SPEND MONIES AS NEEDED FOR SUCH ITEMS AS COMPUTER, INK, COMPUTER PROGRAMS AND MISC ITEMS TO ASSIST IN THEIR SERVICES.

ARTICLE XI-DISCIPLINE

THE ASSOCIATION SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO DISCIPLINE THE CHURCHES OF WHICH IT IS COMPOSED, AND TO WITHDRAW FELLOWSHIP FROM A CHURCH AS A WHOLE WHEN IT'S ACTION IS INCONSISTENT WITH THE DOCTRINE AND USAGE'S OF THE FREE WILL BAPTIST CHURCH, IF LABOR WITH IT IS UNSUC-CESSFUL. BUT IN NO CASE CAN IT REVERSE A DECISION OF A CHURCH.

ARTICLE XII-PRESBYTERY

SECTION 1. THIS BODY OF ORDAINED MINISTERS AND DEACONS SHALL PRO-MOTE FELLOWSHIP, ISSUE CARDS OF GOOD STANDING, PROVIDE OPPORTUNI-TIES FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION, DISCIPLINE IT'S MEMBERS AND ORDAIN NEW MINISTERS TO PREACH THE GOSPEL. SECTION

SECTION 2. NEW PASTORS OF THE SALEM ASSOCIATION SHALL BE EXAMINED AND APPROVED BY THE SALEM PRESBYTERY OR IT'S REPRESENTATIVES. SECTION 3. THE SALEM PRESBYTERY SHALL HAVE IT'S OWN CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS AND WILL FUNCTION AS AN INDEPENDENT BODY FROM THE SALEM ASSOCIATION.

SECTION 4. EACH CHURCH WILL REQUEST THE SALEM PRESBYTERY TO EX-AMINE THEIR NEW PASTOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF CALLING HIM AS THEIR PAS-TOR.

SECTION 5. THE SALEM PRESBYTERY WILL EXAMINE THE NEW PASTOR WITH-IN 30 DAYS OF RECEIVING A REQUEST BY THE CHURCH THAT CALLED HIM.

ARTICLE XIII-AMENDMENTS

HIS CONSTITUTION MAY BE ALTERED OR AMENDED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE ASSOCIATION AT ANY REGULAR ANNUAL SESSION PROVIDED THE SUGGESTED AMENDMENT IS RECEIVED BY THE CLERK IN WRITING 1 DAY BE-FORE A VOTE IS TAKEN.

BY-LAWS

- 1. EACH SESSION OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE CALLED TO ORDER BY THE MODERATOR AND OPENED WITH PRAYER. EACH SESSION SHALL BE CLOSED WITH PRAYER.
- 2. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THE MODERATOR TO PRESERVE ORDER AND SUB-MIT ALL ACTIONS TO THE BODY. HE SHALL HAVE THE SAME RIGHT OF SPEECH AS ANY OTHER MEMBER, BUT HE MUST APPOINT SOMEONE ELSE AS CHAIRMAN WHILE HE SPEAKS. HE SHALL NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE EXCEPT IN CASE OF A TIE.

A. THE MODERATOR SHALL BE CHAIRMAN OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD. B. HE SHALL SEE THAT ALL ACTIONS BY THIS BODY IS CARRIED OUT, UN-LESS OTHERWISE DELEGATED BY THE ASSOCIATION.

- 3. THE VICE-MODERATOR SHALL ASSUME HE DUTIES, RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE MODERATOR IN HIS ABSENCE.
- 4. THE DELEGATES SHALL BE ENROLLED BY HE CLERK BEFORE THEY ARE SEATED IN THIS BODY.
- 5. ALL BUSINESS SHALL BE BROUGHT BEFORE THE BODY BY A MOVE NO A SECOND AND SHALL BE DISPOSED OF ACCORDING TO PARLIAMENTA-RY USAGE.
- 6. A MEMBER WISHING TO MAKE A MOTION OR TO SPEAK IN CONFERENCE, SHALL FIRST RISE, ADDRESS THE MODERATOR, AND BE RECOGNIZED BY HIM BEFORE PROCEEDING. A MEMBER MAY SECOND A MOTION WITHOUT RISING AND ADDRESSING THE MODERATOR.

CONSTITUTION OF THE PRESBYTERY OF THE SALEM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS

ARTICLE I-NAME

THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE PRESBYTERY OF THE SALEM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS OF FLORIDA.

ARTICLE IT-PURPOSE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PRESBYTRY SHALL BE FOR THE FURTHER-ANCE OF THE GOSPEL, TO PROMOTE FELLOWSHIP, ISSUE CARDS OF GOOD STANDING, PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR CONTINUING EDU-CATION (SUCH AS SEMINARS AND RETREATS) AND DISCIPLINE ITS MEMBERS.

ARTICLE III-MEMBERSHIP

THE MEMBERSHIP OF THIS PRESBYTERY SHALL CONSIST OF ALL OR-DAINED MINISTERS AND DEACONS HOLDING CARDS OF GOOD STAND-ING IN THE PRESBYTERY THIS PRESBYTERY MAY INVITE VISITING MINISTERS AND DEACONS TO SIT IN COUNCIL WITH IT IN ANY ASSEM-BLY THEREOF. LICENSED MINISTERS IN GOOD STANDING WITH A MEMBER CHURCH OF THIS ASSOCIATION ARE ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OF THE PRESBYTERY WITH NO VOTING PRIVILEGES.

ARTICLE IV-OFFICERS

THE OFFICERS OF THIS PRESBYTERY SHALL BE MODERATOR, VICE-MODERATOR, CLERK AND TREASURER, WHO SHALL BE ELECTED ANNUALLY AND SHALL SERVE UNTIL THEIR SUCCES-SORS ARE ELECTED AT THE NEXT MEETING.

ARTICLE V-MEETINGS

THE PRESBYTERY SHALL HOLD ANNUAL SESSIONS ON FRIDAY NIGHT OF THE FOURTH SESSION OF THE SALEM ASSOCIATION. CALLED MEETINGS MAY BEHELD AT THE CALL OF THE MODERATOR, OR ANY 5 MEMBERS OF SAID PRESBYTERY WHO DEEM IT NECESSARY, UPON WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE MEMBERS~10 MEMBERS SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM. ARTICLE VI-COMMITTEES

- A. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF THE MODERATOR, THE CLERK, AND THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE EX-AMINATION COMMITTEE.
- B. THE EXAMINATION COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF AT LEAST 3 OR-DAINED MINISTERS ELECTED ANNUALLY BY THE PRESBYTERY THIS COMMITTEE WILL EXAMINE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS CON-CERNING ORDINATION TO THE PRESBYTERY OF NEW MEMBERS.

C. OTHER COMMITTEES, AS THEY ARE NEEDED, MAY BE APPOINTED BY THE MODERATOR

ARTICLE VII-AMENDMENTS

THIS CONSTITUTION MAY BE AMENDED AT ANY REGULAR MEETING OF THE PRESBYTERY BY A 2/3 MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT. BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I- ORDINATION AND RATIFICATION

THIS PRESBYTERY SHALL HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO ESTABLISH GUIDELINES OF APPLICANTS TO THE GOSPEL MINISTRY AND RATIFICA-TION OF THE CREDENTIALS OF ORDAINED MINISTERS TRANSFERRING TO THE SALEM PRESBYTERY

ARTICLE II-CARDS OF GOOD STANDING

THE PRESBYTERY SHALL ANNUALLY ISSUE CARDS OF GOOD STANDING TO MINISTERS . UPON PRESENTATION OF A REPORT IN PERSON OR IN CASE OF SICKNESS OR SOME LEGITIMATE REASON. A LETTER MAY BE ACCEPT-ED. CARDS OF GOOD STANDING SHALL BE ISSUED ANNUALLY TO DEA-CONS UPON PRESENTATION OF A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION FROM THEIR LOCAL CHURCH. A DONATION OF \$5.00 IS REQUESTED. ANY MINIS-TER OR DEACON FAILING TO HOLD A CARD OF GOOD STANDING SHALL NOT HAVE A VOICE IN THIS PRESBYTERY, ANY MINISTER HAVING LOST HIS CARD OF GOOD STANDING MAY BE REINSTATED IN THIS PRESBYTERY UPON THE PRESENTATION OF IDS REPORT AND WHO MANIFEST A SINCERE INTEREST IN THE WORK OF THE LORD. MINISTERS WHO HAVE RETIRED OR REACHED THE AGE OF RETIREMENT AND WHO HAVE CONTINUED TO MANIFEST A SINCERE INTEREST IN THE WORK OF THE LORD MAY BE IS-SUED A LIFETIME CARD OF GOOD STANDING WHICH THEY MAY HOLD AS LONG AS THEY HOLD MEMBERSHIP IN THIS PRESBY-TERY OR AS LONG AS THEIR CONDUCT IS UNOUESTIONABLE. MINISTERS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF CHURCHES IN THE SALEM ASSOCIATION WHO DO NOT HAVE CARDS OF GOOD STANDING DO NOT HAVE THE APPROVAL OF THIS BODY TO PRESENT THEMSELVES IN OTHER FREE WILL BAPTIST MEETINGS AS A FREE WILL BAPTIST MINISTER IN GOOD STANDING.

ARTICLE III-DISCIPLINE

THE PRESBYTERY SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO TRY AND WITHDRAW FELLOWSHIP FROM ANY MEMBER UPON EVIDENCE OF GUILT OF UN-CHRISTIAN CONDUCT, OR WHO IS TEACHING OR PREACHING HERE-SY OR WHO HAS PROVEN TO BE DISLOYAL TO THE TENETS OF FAITH AS EXPRESSED IN THE TREATISE OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST, AS HELD BY THE SALEM ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS OF FLORIDA'


ARTICLE IV-DONATIONS
