Constitution and By-laws of the Salem Association of Free Will Baptists of Florida

PREAMBLE

We, the believers in Christ according to the doctrines of the Free Will Baptist denomination, having been baptized into a like profession of faith in Jesus Christ and properly organized into churches, realizing the necessity of a bond of union and fellowship among us for the preservation of the "Faith Once Delivered Unto the Saints" and spreading of the Gospel of Christ upon earth, do therefore ordain and establish this constitution.

ARTICLE I-NAME

This organization shall be known as the Salem Association of Free Will Baptists of Florida.

ARTICLE II-PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be to unify the work of the churches composing this association by devising and executing such measures as will spread the Gospel of Christ as we interpret it.

ARTICLE II-MEMBERSHIP

Any regularly and organized and well-disciplined Free Will Baptist Church conforming to the usage of the Free Will Baptist Denomination as set forth in the Treatise of the Faith and Practices of the Free Will Baptist of the National Association may upon proper application and voice of the association, become members of the association.

ARTICLE IV-COMPOSITION

Section 1 The sessions of the association shall consist of the delegates appointed or elected by the churches of which this association is composed. All ordained ministers and deacons who are in good standing with the association and the churches to which they belong, shall be standing delegates.

Section 2 Ministers from sister associations who are serving churches in the association shall have the right to make

suggestions, but the voting rights shall be reserved for the delegates of the Salem Association.

Section 3 All officers of the association shall be standing delegates.

ARTICLE V- REPRESENTATION

Each church in the association shall be entitled to one delegate for every 25 members or fraction thereof.

ARTICLE VI- OFFICERS, BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND REPRESENTATIVES

The purpose of each board is to promote itself domestically and internationally within the Salem Association of Free Will Baptists biblically, ethically and morally to formulate and promote a lively program by the aiding of our churches, the establishment of new churches, and by an earnest effort to keep a spirit of revival present in the association.

- Section 1 The officers of the association shall be a moderator, a vice-moderator a clerk-treasurer and an assistant clerktreasurer, who shall be elected every two years on the odd year except to fill vacancies.
- **Section 2** The standing boards of this association shall be the executive board, missions board, youth board and Christian education board.
- **Section 3** The committees of this association shall be committee on committees, resolutions, finance, nominations and obituaries.

Section 4 Representatives:

- A. The association shall elect two lay persons to serve on the Camp Mt. Pleasant board of directors. One member elected each year to serve a two-year term.
- B. The association shall nominate one person annually to represent the association to the Florida State Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VI-BOARDS

- **Section 1** The executive board shall be composed of the officers of the association, the chairperson of each standing board and one representative at large from each church.
- **Section 2** Mission board shall be composed of 5 members elected annually on a rotation basis. The chairperson shall be elected annually.
- **Section 3** Youth board shall be composed of 3 members elected annually on a rotation basis. The chairperson shall be elected annually.
- **Section 4** Christian education board shall be composed of 3 members elected annually on a rotation basis. The chairperson shall be elected annually.

ARTICLE VIII-COMMITTEES

The committees of the association shall be appointed annually.

- **Section 1** Committee on committees will be composed of 3 members appointed by the moderator, to recommend the persons to fill the regular committees of the association.
- Section 2 Regular committees: Resolutions-composed of 3 members.... Nominations-composed of 3 members, Finance-composed of 3 members, and Obituaries composed of 1 member.

ARTICLE IX-SESSIONS/MEETINGS

The sessions of this association shall be held quarterly. The spring and fall sessions will convene on Fri. night before the 2nd Sat. in April and Oct. The summer session will convene on the 2nd Sat. in July and the winter session, which is our annual session, will convene on Fri. night before the 2nd Sat. and the 2nd Sat. in Jan. Annual letters and reports shall be received in this session.

ARTICLE X-FINANCE

Section 1 Churches represented in this body are asked to pay \$90.00 quarterly or \$360.00 annually for the state representative fees.

- **Section 2** Each church is asked to send at least 10% of its income for the cooperative plan of support.
- **Section 3** All cooperative funds coming into this body shall be spent under a budget plan. The budget must be approved by the body while in session.
- **Section 4** The moderator and clerk-treasurer shall receive \$50.00 annually for their services. The clerk-treasurer may spend monies as needed for such items as computer, ink, programs and misc. items to assist in their services.

ARTICLE XI DISCIPLINE

The association shall have the power to discipline the churches of which it is composed and to withdraw fellowship from a church as a whole when its actions is inconsistent with the doctrine and usage of the Free Will Baptist Church, if labor with it is unsuccessful, but in no case can it reverse a decision of a church.

ARTICLE XII-PRESBYTERY

- **Section 1** The body of ordained ministers and deacons shall promote fellowship, issue cards of good standing, provide opportunities for continuing education. The association shall have the power to discipline its members and ordain new ministers to preach the Gospel.
- Section 2 New pastors of the Salem Association shall be examined and approved by the Salem Presbytery or its representatives.
- **Section 3** The Salem Presbytery shall have its own constitution and by-laws and will function as an independent body from the Salem Association.
- **Section 4** Each church will request the Salem Presbytery to examine the new pastor within 30 days of calling him as their pastor.
- **Section 5** The Salem Presbytery will examine the new pastor within 30 days of receiving a request by the church that called him.

ARTICLE XII-AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be altered or amended by a majority vote of the association at any regular annual session provided the suggested amendment is received by the clerk in writing 1 day before a vote is taken.

BY-LAWS

- **Section 1** Each session of this association shall be called to order by the moderator and opened with prayer. Each session shall be closed with prayer.
- Section 2 It shall be the duty of the moderator to preserve order and submit all actions to the body. He shall have the same right of speech as any other member he must appoint someone else as chairman while he speaks. He shall not have the right to vote except in case of a tie.
 - A. The moderator shall be chairman of the executive board.
 - **B.** He shall see that all actions by this body is carried out, unless otherwise delegated by the association.
- **Section 3** Vice-moderator shall assume the duties, rights and privileges of the moderator, in his absence.
- **Section 4** The delegates shall be enrolled by the clerk before they are seated in this body.
- **Section 5** All business shall be brought before the body by a move and a second and shall be disposed of according to parliamentary.
- Section 6 A member wishing to make a motion or to speak in conference, shall first rise, address the moderator and be recognized by him before proceeding. A member may second a motion without rising and addressing the moderator.

Constitution and By-laws of the Presbytery of the Salem Association of Free Will Baptists of Florida

Article 1-Name

This organization shall be known as The Presbytery of the Salem Association of Free Will Baptist of Florida.

Article 2-Purpose

The purpose of this Presbytery shall be for the furtherance of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, to promote fellowship, issue cards of good standing, provide opportunities for continuing education (seminars and retreats) and discipline its members.

Article 3-Membership

The membership of this Presbytery shall consist of all Ordained Ministers and Deacons holding cards of good standing in this Presbytery. This Presbytery may invite visiting Ministers and Deacons to sit in council with it in any assembly thereof. Licensed Ministers in good standing with a member church of this Association are associate members of this Presbytery with no voting privileges.

Article 4-Officers

The officers of this Presbytery shall be Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk/Treasurer, who shall be elected annually and shall serve until their successors are elected at the next meeting.

Article 5–Meetings

The Presbytery shall hold a meeting at the Annual session of The Salem Association. The Moderator or Vice–Moderator may call a meeting at any other session of the Salem Association also. A meeting between sessions can be called by the Moderator or Vice-Moderator or any 5 members of said Presbytery who deem it necessary, with 2 weeks written notice to the membership. 10 members constitute a quorum.

Article 6-Committees

a) The Discipline Committee shall consist of the Moderator, The Clerk, Chairman of Examining Committee or his representative from the Examining committee.

- b) The Examining Committee shall consist of 3 Ordained Ministers elected on rotation of 3-year terms by the Presbytery. This committee will examine and make recommendations concerning Ordination to the Presbytery, of new members.
- c) Other committees, as they are needed, may be appointed by the Moderator.

Article 7-Amendments

This constitution may be amended at any regular meeting of the Presbytery by a 2/3 majority of the members present.

By-Laws

Article 1-Ordination and Ratification

This Presbytery shall have the responsibility to establish guidelines of applicants to the Gospel Ministry and ratification of the credentials of ordained Ministers transferring to the Salem Presbytery.

Article 2-Cards of Good Standing

The Presbytery shall annually issue cards of good standing to Ministers upon presentation of a report in person or in case of sickness or some legitimate reason. A letter may be accepted. Cards of good standing shall be issued annually to Deacons upon presentation of a letter of recommendation from their local church. Any Minister or Deacon failing to hold a card of good standing shall not have a voice in this Presbytery. Any Minister having forfeited his card of good standing may be reinstated in this Presbytery upon the presentation of his report and who manifest a sincere interest in the work of the LORD. Ministers who are members of churches in the Salem Association who do not have cards of good standing do not have the approval of this body to present themselves in other Free Will Baptist meetings as a Free Will Baptist Minister in good standing.

Article 3-Discipline

The Presbytery shall have the power to try and withdraw fellowship from any member upon evidence of guilt of unchristian conduct, or who is teaching or preaching heresy or who has proven to be disloyal to the tenets of faith as expressed in the

treatise of the National Association of Free Will Baptists, as held by the Salem Association of Free Will Baptists of Florida.

Article 4-Donations

Each member of the Presbytery shall be asked to donate \$5.00 annually upon presentation of his report. This fund is to be used for acquiring necessary equipment, the printing of such materials as cards of good standing, constitution and by-laws, stationary, minutes of meetings, and for defraying of necessary travel and mailing expenses, and other expenses as authorized by the Presbytery.

Article 5-Call of a New Pastor

Any church considering the call of a pastor should contact the Examining Committee with any questions they may have about policy and/or procedure. If the minister being considered does not hold Free Will Baptist credentials from another National Affiliated Association, he must come before the Examining Committee before the church votes to call him as Pastor to prevent the Church from being out of fellowship with the Salem Association.

If the Minister holds credentials of like faith his credentials may be ratified by the Examining Committee and Presbytery. If the Minister does not hold credentials of like faith, he must follow the procedures of Licensing and Ordination of a Minister being Ordained to the Gospel Ministry. (**Like faith** is that which is consistent and practice that is primarily Baptistic in nature.)

Article 6-Amendments

These By-Laws may be amended at any meeting of the Presbytery by a 2/3 majority vote of members present.
