I have preached one sermon and married one couple. Have not been able to attend services for some time.

W. F. VICKERY Route 4 Broken Arrow, California

I have pastored Rickey Chapel and Pirtle Church half time each. Preached 49 sermons, witnessed 3 conversions. Had 6 additions to church. Traveled 394 miles, received \$166.33 at Rickey Chapel. Preached 54 sermons, had 11 conversions, 14 additions to church. Traveled 1350 miles, received \$166.07. Assisted in revival at O'Kean, Alice Brooks, Arbor Grove, New Covenant, Warm Springs, Little Brown, and Mt. Zion, total 123 sermons, witnessed 31 conversions, 20 additions, traveled 2192 miles, received \$419.05.

- 5. Be it resolved that the Social Band Association set Sept. 1 as the date to complete its years work. That all reports and church books be closed as of that date.
- 6. Be it resolved that each church give the sum of \$6.00 to a national association expense fund to pay the delegates expense also association fees.
- 7. Be it resolved that this association give a rising vote of thanks to Brother Wayne Tucker for his faithful services as evangelist.
- 8. Be it resolved that your committee wish to express our thanks and appreciation to the Sutton church and community for the kindness and hospitality shown us during the association.
