5. We recommend that each church cooperate with the other Miss. Churches in having a Bible College Day for the building program. The suggested day is Nov. 18, but the churches are asked to set dates at their own convenience nearest to that day. Passed.

6. We recommend that the association put some restrictions on deacons as to meeting the Assn. Each church should send a letter of good standing for its deacons in order for them to have a vote in the Assn. Passed.
