We the Business Committee, recommend that this yearly conference buy a projector for the purpose of showing religious films in our churches, and that a person be appointed by the yearly conference as custodian of said property. 15/ Committee.

Motion was made by Rev. Howard Flata and, seconded by Rev. C. J. Kettner to buy projector. Motion lost.

We the Business Committee recommend that the trustees of this yearly Conference be given the power to continue to act in behalf of the interest of the yearly conference and that this yearly conference pay all expenses involved in work-time loss and transportation.

Motion was made by Rev. George Ritter and seconded by Rev. Carl Williams to pay expenses to claim property and sue trustees. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Rev. Willie Huffman and seconded by Bro. Floyd Steward to adopt the three resolutions that passed and release the committee. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Dwight Dame and seconded by Rev. C. J. Kettner to inform pastors of the problems of liquor and appoint a representative of this article. Motion carried. Rev. Wallace Malone was appointed.

Motion was made by Rev. Claude Chidester and seconded by Rev. Everett Beatty that this yearly conference suggest churches pay their pastors' expenses to the National Association

A special session of the yearly was called by the moderator Saturday Feb. 16, 1951 at 2:00 P.M. meeting in the Ida Free Will Baptist church at Ida, Ill.

Special was called to order by clerk with business; 26 Ordained ministers and 26 Ordained Deacons present.

Freedom County had 17 delegates present Wayne Co. had 4 delegates present with 33 Delegates present from Franklin Co.

Motion was made by Rev. Hosea Smith and seconded by Rev. John Hiltibidal that the delegates of the three counties be seated motion carried.

Letter was read by Rev. George Waggoner from the Sawyer.

United Prayer lead by Rev. George Pitts.

(1) motion was made by Rev. George Pitts and seconded by Rev. John Hiltibidal to give trustee's right to borrow money to acquire the land left to The Free Will Baptist Church as a Church Denomination by the late Rev. Elmer O. Warren. Also to be free to work with owners of the land to sell or keep as they see fit in behalf of the Southern Ill. Conference. Motion carried

(2) Motion was made by Rev. ~~George~~ Robert Norman and seconded by Rev. Claude Childers. That if the property is sold the proceeds be used to pay all expenses and bills acquired in acquiring the land and the remainder be put in the yearly Conference treasure. Motion carried.

(3) Motion made by Rev. C. J. Kettman and seconded by Rev. Claude Childers to assess each church \$2. now to meet the immediate obligations of the Conference. ~~Motion Carried~~

Motion was made by ~~Wm~~ D. Davis and seconded by Rev. Carl Williams to amend the first motion. That a free will offering be sent from each church of \$2. or more to be sent to the treasurer within 2 weeks to meet this obligation. Motion carried.

(4) Motion was made by Rev. Leslie Elliott and seconded by Eugene Kling. That the yearly dues be raised from \$5.00 per year to \$7.50. To keep out of the red. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Rev. Carl Williams and seconded by Rev. Paul Selcer to adjourn. Motion carried.
