Motion was made by Rev. Leslie Elliott and seconded by Rev. C. J. Ketterman that we adopt this plan. motion lost.

The credentials committee gave their report as follows: we the credentials committee recommend that all those reporting be given cards of ordination and others be given licensed cars by this yearly conference except Berlin & Lucille Scarborough. Their card held concerning matters of doctrine.

Motion was made by Rev. Leon McBride and seconded by Rev. Chester Breeze that we accept this report and grant the cards. motion carried.

Motion was made by Rev. John Giltibidal and seconded by Rev. Howard Blota that we retain the Credential Committee for 30 days and consider all reports that come in. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Rev. Leslie Elliott and seconded by Rev. Cecil Walker that delegates to the National be paid \$15 of their expense. Motion carried.

Mrs. Kathryn Waggoner, Gester Lewis Willis Childers, Ed Robillard and Freda McClaskey were nominated as delegates to the National Association.

Motion was made by Rev. Leon Mc Bride and seconded by Rev. Wallace Malone that nominations cease and to proceed to elect by acclamation. Motion carried.

The next yearly conference will meet with the Wayne Co. quarterly, the Wednesday night before the 4th Sunday in June.
