

Minutes of the No.. 2 Quarterly Meeting
of the Southern Association of
Free Will Baptists.

Date: February 7 & 8, 1964 Place: Lamont Free Will Baptist Church, Lamont, Calif.

Friday Night, Feb. 7, 1964





November 13, 1964 (Friday Night)


Resolution Committee Report No. 1 Carried - "Be it resolved that we give the host church a standing vote of thanks for the noon meal and their hospitality."
