By-Laws and Rules of the Conference

The Annual Conference appointed a Council Board for the purpose of protecting the interest of the St. Annah Free Will Baptist Conference.

Their duties are as follows:

- 1. Appoint three men that believe whole heartedly in Free Will Baptist Doctrine.
- 2. These three men must be capable of doing a good job.
- 3. A minister must not be a member of this Council Board.
- 4. The Council must make a thorough investigation of any minister who desires to join the Conference. They may approve or disapprove of him according to his record and faith.

- 5. The Council should settle problems that may originate between the Pastor and his Church if the Church fails to make a settlement with him.
- 6. A minister who leaves this Conference and joins another profession of faith must come before the Council Board before he can return to this Conference.
- 7. The Treasurer has the power, if a minister or deacon comes to him for aid, to write a check without going to the Conference.
- 8. No person is to speak on any one thing more than two times in a Conference.

By-Laws Concerning the Churches and Deacons

- 1. All Churches must come to the rules and regulations of the Conference to be orthodox.
- 2. If any member goes contrary he must be tried by his church.
- 3. All Sunday School should be governed by the Superintendent. They must approve the Superintendent in its Conference.
- 4. No Church is required to deed its property to this Conference.
- 5. Any Church letter having been read and voted that they are in fellowship is entitled to pass in the Unions meetings and Annual Conference.
- 6. Ministers from other Conferences should be in good standing with the Conference 2 to 4 years to be eligible for Moderator.
- 7. No member or minister may be an officer of the law.
- 8. Any person must be orthodox with his church to hold any office in said Conference.
- 9. Each church should be an independent body, governed by the officials.
- 10. Any church that has its Pastor and wishes to become a member of the Conference must be approved by the Council Board before he can be ordained. He can serve his church, but he can't Pastor any other church for a period of twelve months, all other laws apply.
- 11. Each Pastor must be governed by the Deacons.
- 12. Each church should have three or more Deacons or Deaconesses.
- 13. Any organization or any business is prohibited to be carried on in the church unless the members are orthodox in their church.
- 14. Qualification of a Deacon: He must be loyal to his church. He must have an honest and good report of his character. If he walks disorderly before the church, he must be tried by his church. He may be set aside for further consideration.
