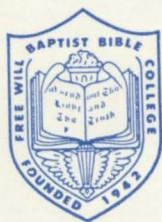

The Twenty-fourth Annual Session of the Texas State Free Will Baptist Association, met with the First Free Will Baptist Church in Waco, Texas, November 1. 1933.

Vaughn of North Zulch, Texas. Lesson read from 3rd. chapter of Revelation. Prayer. Rev. J. R. Davidson, Bryan, Texas. Subject of sermon; "The Victorious Church." Benediction, Rev. E. J. Vaughn.

Secretary-Treasurer was instructed to reimburse Program Committee for expenses of printing programs for the present session of the Association and a vote of thanks was tendered Rev. M. L. Sutton for an offer to print next years programs, gratis.

The chair appointed Committee on Committees, as follows: Rev. J. K. Warkentin, Randall Davidson and Rev. T. H. Newsom.

Dr. W. C. Scarbrough introduced W. C. Scarbrough, Jr. Wright Bounds, Miss Bernice Jones, Miss Dell Keith and Villan Sullins, who presented a playlet, "An Operation For Sin," which was well received.

Miss Gladys Sparks then commented on the play as showing the importance of Bible Study, of Prayer and of Church Attendance as against Selfishness, Stubbornness, Stinginess and Indifference. "Her comments" being one of the high points of the Association.

A collection for Missions was then taken and \$14.26 was added to the Foreign Mission Fund.

Rev. J. K. Warkentin then sang as a solo, "The Wayfaring Pilgrim."

8:00 o'clock. A part of the first chapter of Corinthians, verses 20 to 26 inclusive was read by Rev. M. L. Sutton after which he, Bro. Sutton, delivered the Association a sermon. Text, "How is it then Brethren, when ye come together," which was well spoken and well received.

## REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON FOREIGN MISSIONS

Through investigation, we have been persuaded that a spirit of interest is growing in Mission Work over the State of Texas,



however, it is easy to recognize the fact that there is still room for revival in this field of endeavor.

We have at the present time four missionaries on the foreign fields, two in India and two in South America. Brother and Sister Willey are laboring in the Gospel in South America and Sister Laura Belle Barnard in South India, with an additional native missionary, namely Paul, in India.

Beside the responsibility of our people in supporting the Willey family and Paul, Miss Barnard is compelled to have a clan of helpers in order to carry on her particular part of the work, thus necessitating an increase in expenses. This being true it becomes necessary for an increase in the offerings for this great cause from the entire field, hence we urge that the churches over our State increase said offerings.

Brother C. F. Goen of Bryan, Texas; is State Secretary and Treasurer of Foreign Missions, therefore we recommend that each Pastor keep the necessity of his people's cooperation in regular offerings to be sent to the State Secretary and Treasurer.

We, your Committee on Temperance beg to submit the following; Whereas, the cause of Temperance has, during the past political administration suffered temporary defeat because of repeal of our most effectual constitution amendment, therefore be it resolved, that this Association here and now go on record as being uncompromisingly opposed to any further repeal of the laws which shall guarantee to us immunity from the sale or manufacture of intoxicating beverage in any way, and that we, as a body of christian believers will use every means within our power, both in our public worship and our private life and at the public voting places to defeat that element who are using every scheme they can conceive to bring upon us the free use and sale of all kinds intoxicating beverages, the general use and sale of which can only bring public and private ruin.
