Minutes of the sixth anniversary of the Tow River Association held with Jack's Creek Church, Yancy County, N.C., Aug. 17<sup>th</sup>, 1855.

2. Called for correspondence from sister associations, and received elder Jas Hall with a packet of minutes from the Marion Association, who also took his seat with us.
3. Agree to send corresponding delegates to the Marion Association, John Wheeler, E.L. Campbell, M. Peterson, S.D. Byrd with a letter and 20 minutes.
4. Agree to hold union meetings resolution, the association recommends to the churches the right of an appeal from one church to another for justice in litigated points.

Note the moderator called for a presbytery of ministers for the ordination of Jas Dikes on Monday.
