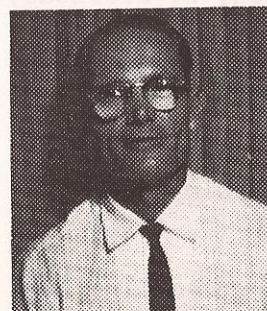
Ed was a real friend. When you know where something is: It is not lost.
