Charles Thigpen gave greetings from the Tennessee State Association, "God is faithful to keep his promises." He informed the Association of the Walk-a-thon for foreign mission on September 20, 2003, the Unified Ministry Plan of church giving, and the Tri-state FWB Christian Workers Conference on November 1, 2003, to be held at First FWB Church in Elizabethton. He asked that we support the work of the FWB. He encouraged anyone who did not receive the state FWB paper, "Echo", and the national FWB magazine, "Contact", to sign up for them.

Bro. Verlin Anderson, missionary from the Ivory Coast, spoke about the mission work in Africa. Seventy distinct language groups in the Ivory Coast to be reached. Two percent are being ministered too. We need to reach twenty five percent to make a culture shift. Pray for the childrens school and the Bible Insitution, which was affected by the war in that area.

Bro. Roy Roach gave a report of the FWB Family Ministries at Greenville. Thirty seven children saved or rededicated in the last quarter. Sixty nine in the last six months. Homecoming is October 11, 2003, everyone is welcome to come and tour the facilities. We could use paper goods and detergent, for the pounding in November. Bro. Roach turned it over to Bro. James Kilgore, the director of Family Ministries to finish the report.

Bro. Kilgore stated that Toe River Churches gave over \$20,000 to the work, up \$200 from last year. We are trying to develop and assistant living ministry for the elderly and a ministry for child care. We are in need of house parents. Pray for these needs and thank you for your support. If you ever need the childrens home, we are available.

Bro. Dexter Brummitt gave information on the Walk-a-thon, which will be held September 20, 2003, or any day that you wish. Please get your church involved to support the tremendous work God is doing on foreign fields.
