Of the First Annual Session of the Union Hill Freewill Baptist Association of Alabama which met with Union Hill church September 29th, 1921. Sermon introductory to business was preached by Rev. W. A. Davis. Dismissed until 1.30 o'clock.

At 1:30 o'clock body called to order by the moderator who read the first Psalm: then had prayer by B. F. Pate. Called for letters and enrolled delegates, and then elected B. F. Pate Moderator and W. R. Kirkland Clerk. Called for corresponding delegates and received A. L. Pate, W. A. Elmore, and R. A. Elmore from the Liberty Association and extended them the right hand of fellowship. Then appointed a committee on Divine Service: W. A. Elmore, Sam Carrell, W. H. Peters: moved to retain the old Executive Committee; moved to retain Sam Carrell on Sabbath Schools; appointed the various committees; then appointed C. I. Wells, R. D. Bell, H. W. Norris to the Liberty Association; W. A. Davis and C. I. Wells to State Line; B. F. Pate and C. I. Wells to the South Eastern; and Lee Wilson and W. J. Garner to the Salem. Moved to adjourn till 8:30 o'clock morning.

Friday Morning.

Met at 8:30 o'clock; song by the congregation; lesson by Rev. A. L. Pate and prayer by him. Moved to call the roll, renewed call for letters from churches; renewed call for correspondents and received M. L. Hall from the Liberty Association. Moved to divide the money in the treasury which was \$6.75. We paid them \$3.37. Called for the report of the various committees. Moved to seat brother John Marlow from the State Line. Adjourned for preaching.

Body called to order by moderator with song, and prayer by H. W. Norris, at 1;30 o'clock.

REPORT ON DECORUM;—Called for report of the Committee on Decorum and adopted the Liberty Association Decorum except the 16th section where it says to "commune and wash feet two times a year," one time a year instead, or if any church wants to commune more they are at liberty to do so.

NEXT SESSION—Moved that the next session of the Association be held at Bethel church to commence Thursday before the first Sunday in October, 1922, and the next Union Meeting be held with Hinson church on Saturday before the second Sunday in July, 1922.

MINUTES:-Moved to have 200 minutes printed.

INTRODUCTORY:—S. M. Tindell to preach the Introductory Sermon, H. W. Norris alternate. C. I. Wells to preach the Introductory in Union Meeting.

Then sang a song and we adjourned to meet with Bethel church Thursday before the first Sunday in October, 1922. B. F. Pate, moderator, W. R. Kirkland, clerk.
