ASSOCIATIONAL PROCEEDINGS

WHEREAS: we wish to protect our association from the inroads of Barthianism, current neo-evangelicalism, philosophical relativism and modern scientism, as well as to protest the vitiating effects of liberal theology upon both Church and society;
