money is divided in the following manner:

50% general fund

20% Camp Joshau fund

25% superannuation fund

5% home missions

Amend to read as follows:

"ASSOCIATIONAL PROGRAM MONIES WILL BE DIVIDED AS  
FOLLOWS:

60% GO TO GENERAL FUND

20% GO TO CAMP JOSHUA FUND

5% GO TO SUPERANNUATION FUND

15% GO TO HOME MISSION FUND"

## GENERAL BOARD REPORT

January 19, 1993, Tuesday

MSC That the General Board recommend that the Superannuation Committee look into changing standing rule # 11, page 8, of the Constitution and By-Laws, due to the fact that the superannuation program is closed to any new members and we only have one minister who is eligible to draw money at the present. The change would be as follows

concerning the per cent of money going into Superannuation from the Associational Program money. Superannuation fund would receive 5% instead of 25%, and that 55% go into the General Fund, 20% to the Camp Fund, and 20% to the Home Mission Fund.

The moderator ask Brother Howard Munsey to write a job description for the different committees, boards, and officers of the Union Association.

The Board outlined the program for 1993 annual meeting with speakers.

MSC to use same format as last year's program.

The invitation has been extended to Church Hill First FWB Church to host the annual meeting in 1994, and they have accepted the invitation.

## PROCEEDINGS

WEDNESDAY MORNING AUGUST 11, 1993

Rev. Winston Sweeney, President of the Union Association Minister's Conference called the Annual session to order promptly at 9:30 a.m. The meeting was held in the fellowship hall of the Faith Free Will Baptist Church of Johnson City, Tennessee. Dr. Charles Thigpen, State Promotional Secretary, led the opening prayer.

The President named a three man Committee on Committees and Nominations as follows: Norman Heath, Teddy Webb and Randy Tipton.

Rev. Jack Taylor read the Eastern, Central and Western Quarterly Meeting License Council reports. On motion these reports were adopted.

On motion the Rev. Raymond Riggs, recently installed Pastor of Sparta First Free Will Baptist Church was received into the fellowship of the Minister's Conference upon recognition of his long history, years of service and reputation as a Free Will Baptist minister.

A motion was sustained that the memory of deceased ministers Rev. Doug Roberson. Rev. Martin Oxendine, Rev. Ermine Butler and Rev. Roy Minnis Lamb be especially honored in a moment of silent prayer.

Rev. James Cox was presented who conducted a seminar on "Sermon Preparation and Delivery." He read devotionally from Nehemiah 1:1-8 before presenting a study containing much needed and helpful information, especially useful to ministers who have been unable to get formal training. It was a pity that many of those who needed it most did not avail themselves of this unique privilege and opportunity.

At 9:45 a.m. the session was recessed for the noon worship service to be reconvened at 2:00 p.m.

### WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON

Brother Sweeney then presented Rev. James Cox who continued the seminar on "Sermon Preparation and Delivery" which he began during the morning session. The Minister's Conference expresses its gratitude to Brother Cox for this helpful and informative study.

Prayer requests were presented by many of those present and a season of prayer, led by Rev. Gary Lovitt was held as the meeting adjourned to meet again at 7:00 p.m. for the Ordination service.

## THURSDAY EVENING ORDINATION SERVICE

Rev. Winston Sweeney called the evening service to order and Chris Dotson led the congregation in singing "Living In Canaan Now". Brother Ed Hall then led the opening prayer. The people were heartily welcomed to the service and a good Spirit was present as the house filled to near capacity.

Dr. Charles Thigpen, State Promotional Director, gave a brief eulogy on the life and influence of Rev. Ermine Butler, former Pastor of the Faith Church where he served for twenty five years prior to his death. He was also a member of the Ordaining Council. Dr. Thigpen quoted Rev. 14:13, "And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors,; and their works do follow them." A moment of silent prayer was observed in Brother Butler's memory, after which Dr. Thigpen led in prayer.

The Secretary of the Ordaining Council introduced the Council members and presented the candidates for ordination, Rev. Robert Scott Cline and Rev. James Keith Williams. Reverend's Lynn Roberts, Kenneth Wilson and Billy Barlow were introduced whose credentials were to be ratified. A total of sixty ministers were present for the meeting.

The Faith church choir sang two special songs: "When I've Traveled My Last Mile" and "Give Me A Double Portion." These were sung with great enthusiasm to the delight of the assembled congregation.

Rev. Gerald Fender rallied the troops in a promotional talk concerning the annual "Tennessee Walk-A-Thon for Foreign Missions" to be held next September.

The congregation sang "Some Glad Day" as the offering was received. Rev. E. Y. Bailey led the offertory prayer. The offering amounted to \$237.79.

Rev. Bobby Olterman was presented who preached the ordination sermon. Reading from 2 Tim. 4:1-5,

Brother Olterman preached from the subject of "The Urgency To Proclaim The Gospel." The text for the message was read from (1 Cor. 9:16), " For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!"

3. To strengthen the faith of the flock.  
(1 Cor. 2:5)
4. To receive a crown of glory. (v.4)

After this timely and fitting message Rev. Donnie Bailey gave the charge to the candidates and Rev. Arthur Luster led the prayer of consecration. On a motion properly seconded the men were received into the fellowship of the Minister's Conference.

Brother Leo Martin sung, "The Longer I Serve Him, The sweeter He Grows." The newly received ministers were extended the hand of fellowship by the entire congregation.

Missionary James Munsey who had arrived during the time of the service was asked to share a word from Mexico, his field of labor. He spoke briefly about God's blessing on the work and introduced Brother Lionel Martinez, a man from his field who gave a testimony, expressing his thanks to Free Will Baptists for sending the gospel to he and his people.
