GENERAL BOARD REPORT

Jan.23, 1996 Session was called to order by Rev. Ronnie Adkins. Rev. Alfred Cutshall led us in prayer.

UNION WOMEN ACTIVE FOR CHRIST

The 1996 Union Women Active for Christ was called to order by the Assistant Co-ordinator, Varnell Gorenflo. Frances Shelley led in prayer.

Our morning devotions were presented by Drema Hobbs. She followed the theme "The Gift of God", and read the corresponding verse of scripture, II Cor. 9:15, "Thanks be unto God for His unspeakable gift.". She encouraged us with these words of wisdom:

PROCEEDINGS

Wednesday Morning August 14, 1996

Rev. Gerald Fender called the meeting to order and asked Brother Teddy Webb to lead the opening prayer. The President then appointed the Committee on Committees and Nominations for the annual session as follows: Glenn Hall, Chris Dotson, and Thurman Sullivan.
