PROCEEDINGS

Wednesday Morning (August 12, 1998)

The Ministers' Conference Annual Session convened with the Midfield F.W.B. Church on August 12, 1998.

President Gerald Fender called the meeting to order and asked Bro. Winston Sweeney to open in prayer. President Fender then appointed a nominating committee consisting of Bro. Alfred Cutshall, Bro. Jackie Cole, and Bro. Carl Callahan.

Bro. Thurman Sullivan, ordaining council clerk, was recognized to read a partial report of the ordaining council. MSC to adopt this report with the exception of Point IV (see Appendix 2). MSC to lay Point IV of the ordaining council report on the table until Thursday, August 13, 1998.

Following these items of business, President Fender introduced the conference speaker, Bro. Kevin Trimble. After scripture (Deuteronomy 6:1-25) and prayer, Bro. Trimble began his seminar on "Ministering to Today's Families". During his seminar, Bro. Trimble presented five necessities to ministering to families today. The two necessities discussed during the morning session were:

At the conclusion of Bro. Trimble's morning presentation, the Ministers' Conference was recessed for lunch to meet again at 2:00 p.m.

Wednesday Afternoon (August 12, 1998)

The Ministers' Conference reconvened at 2:00 p.m. with President Gerald Fender presiding. President Fender asked Vice President Larry Arrowood to open the afternoon session with a devotion. Vice President Arrowood gave a brief devotion from Philippians 3 reminding us to have a clear vision.

Following the nominating committee report, Bro. Kevin Trimble resumed his seminar on "Ministering to Today's Families". Bro. Trimble used the afternoon session to discuss three more necessities for ministering to today's families. These three necessities were:

3. We must raise the standard.
4. We must realign the structure of the family.
5. We must reconcile the shattered families.

Bro. Trimble concluded his seminar in prayer.

President Fender presented Bro. Thurman Sullivan to read the reports of the various Quarterly Licensing Councils. Before reading the reports of the Quarterly Licensing Councils, however, a list of the ministers not reporting in writing to the Union Association Ministers' Conference was read. MSC to adopt the reports of the Quarterly Licensing Councils (see Appendix 3).

MSC to give a \$100.00 honorarium to the conference speaker.

MSC to give \$150.00 to the Union Association to assist in the printing of the minutes for the 126th Annual Union Association.

President Fender then presented Bro. Terry Mosley to lead the afternoon prayer service.

MSC to adjourn the Ministers' Conference until Thursday afternoon. The Ministers' Conference was scheduled to reconvene on Thursday afternoon to vote on Point IV of the ordaining council report (see Appendix 2).

Thursday Afternoon (August 13, 1998)

The Ministers' Conference reconvened on Thursday afternoon with President Gerald Fender presiding.

MSC to remove from the table Point IV of the ordaining council report (see Appendix 2).

After some discussion, the Ministers' Conference adopted Point IV of the ordaining council report (see Appendix 2).

MSC to give this year's ordaining council the right to call a special ordination service, if necessary, to ordain any minister affected by the adoption of Point IV of the ordaining council report.

MSC to exclude, from the printing of the Ministers' Conference minutes, ordaining council minutes relating to meetings with Dr. Joseph Wallis.

Thursday Evening (August 13, 1998)

The evening service began with the beautiful singing of the Midfield F.W.B. Church choir. Bro. Chris Dotson then involved the entire congregation in singing "I've Got That Old Time Religion in My Heart". Following another song, Bro. Alfred Cutsall led us in prayer.

Bro. Gerald Fender, president of the Ministers' Conference, called the Ministers' Conference into session and extended a welcome to the congregation. Bro. Fender also expressed gratitude to the host church.

Following the welcome by Bro. Fender, the Ministers' Conference took time to enjoy the kindness of Bro. Jimmie Lowe. Bro. Lowe graciously gave away some Bible software. Bro. Fender also used this time to announce the building dedication of the West Knoxville F.W.B. Church, as well as, to announce some retreats at Free Will Baptist Family Ministries.

Bro. Jimmie Lowe, ordaining council chairman, was introduced to present the members of the ordaining council. Bro. Lowe also introduced the candidates for ratification of credentials, exchange of credentials, and ordination. At the conclusion of Bro. Lowe's introductions, Bro. Fender introduced the officers of the Ministers' Conference.

Bro. Chris Dotson led the congregation in singing "He Lives". An offering of \$302.00 was received.

Bro. Chris Fannin was then recognized to announce an upcoming Missionary Conference at the Oak Grove F.W.B. Church. One of the missionaries to be present at the conference, Bro. Paul Park, shared briefly his burden for Korean ministries.

Following some wonderful special music, Bro. Fender introduced Bro. Billy Gragg, ordaining council representative (1999), to preach the ordination message. Using Jeremiah 6:16 as his text, Bro.
