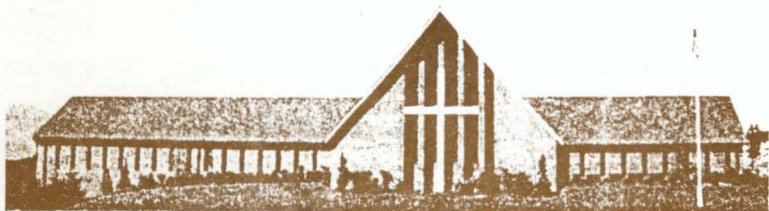

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Tuesday Evening

A splendid crowd of over 225 people gathered for this kickoff session of the Union FWB Association. We heard some uplifting music and had inspirational messages brought by 4 ordination candidates, Johnny Marshall, Johnny "Bo" Ragon, James Lawson, and Steve Freeman. This was the largest audience ever for a Tuesday night service.

Wednesday Morning

Opened in song "I Am Thankful" by Chris Dotson. We then were called to order by Moderator Robert Hobbs who asked Rev. Norman Heath to lead us in prayer. He then appointed the Committee on Committees consisting of Ken Smith, Bob Powers and Teddy Webb.

The Moderator then appointed Carl Callahan as Parliamentarian. MSC to deviate from the program. Carl Callahan brought our morning devotion from Ester 2:17 on "The Church". Bro. Hobbs appointed nominating committee Chris Dotson, Glenn Hall, and Bobbie Greene.

Gerald Fender represented the work in West Knoxville.

9:55am Bro. Holt introduced Rev. Robert Hobbs to bring the Moderator's message. He brought an inspiring message from Ex 14:15.

10:10am Reports continues with Rick Acres representing Master's Men and Dr. Thigpen representing the FWBBC.]

10:25am Offering for FWBFM. Laura Munsey played a piano solo as an offering of \$60 was received.

10:30am The following reports were given and adopted.(see Digest of Reports)
Statistician, General Board, UA Promotional Secretary reports by Larry Laughlin/Clerk. Treasurer's report by Thurman Pate/Treas. UDWAC Report by Mila Laughlin/Secretary. Thurman Pate gave the Appreciation Report.

11:00am Chris Dotson led us in "Trust and Obey". Johnny Marshall sang "I am Redeemed" for our special music. Bro. Dotson then led us in "Jesus Paid It All". Rev. Leon Simmons, pastor Greeneville 1st FWBC, brought the morning message IKings 21:1-3

"I Will Not Sell Reputation/Character/

Power of the Holy Ghost/Word of God.""Buy the Truth and Sell It Not". Bro. Hobbs then extended an altar call. MSC to dismiss until 2pm.

2:00pm Led in prayer by Howard Munsey. Chris Dotson led us in "At Calvary". Rev. Sonny Thomas brought our scripture/prayer from Acts 5:12 "Adding the Multitudes". The following committee reports were given and adopted. (see Digest of Reports)

Moderator Hobbs appointed a committee consisting of Carl Callahan, Chris Dotson, and Travis Sturgill to revise the Constitution and By-laws. MSC to meet in 2001 at Limestone FWBC. Rev. Hobbs then appointed Gale Eidson, Mila Laughlin, Helen Brown, Arlene Farley, and Betty Hall as delegates to the State Association with Sis. Pruitt and Dreama Hobbs as alternates. MSC to adjourn until Aug.14,2001, at Limestone FWBC.
