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Wednesday Afternoon

Moderator Jimmie Tolbert called the 130th annual session to order, with 34 ministers 2 deacons 2 delegates 9 visitors 3 state/national officers and 7 missionaries present for the afternoon service. Wednesday evening, after the Christian Education service, Moderator Tolbert called the association back into special session. A motion to dissolve the Christian Education Board and turn their service back to the General Board and give all remaining funds they had in the treasury to the summer youth camp was laid on the table to be voted on during the Thursday business session.

Thursday Morning

Registration began at 8:30am and continued till 9:00am. The morning session began with Bro. Dotson leading us in "At the Cross". Assistant Moderator, Robert Hobbs, called the 130th Annual Session of the Union Association to order. He then introduced Pastor Harold Blakenship who read scripture from Prov. 15 and led us in prayer. We then had greetings from 3 of the 4 quarterly meetings. Thurman Pate gave the Union Treasurer's report

Luke Shipley represented the Barnabas Connection and gave a report on the activities they are doing.
This ministry is under the direction of Rodney Bailey

Kevin Trimble gave a report on the Summer Youth Camp, he also announced the 2003 Camp would be Senior Week - June 8-12 and Junior Week - June 15-19 State Moderator, Terry Eagleton, was introduced to explain the new Unified Budget Plan that the State wishes to implement

Larry Laughlin made a clarification and an explanation of the difference between a home mission and a reporting church. We then took a 5 minute break.

To begin the morning worship service, Bro. Dotson led in congregational singing. And prayer was offered by Howard Munsey. Rev. Roy Roach brought a very inspirational message on the subject "And Everything by Prayer".

Brother Dotson led us in "Where the Soul Never Dies". Shane Wilson read Matthew 7:14 and led in prayer.

Travis Sturgill suggested amending the Constitution to extend the Promotional Secretary's term from 1 year to indefinite. This will be laid on the table for 1 year. MSC

MSC to give honoriums to the Moderator, host church, Clerk, and Treasurer in the same amounts as last year.

The Moderator asked for delegates to the State Association: Gale Eidson was the only volunteer. MSC to give the Moderator the authority to fill the other positions at the meeting. MSC to adjourn, dismissed in prayer by Alfred Cutshall
