

42nd SESSION PROCEEDINGS

The 42nd session of the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptist convened with the First Free Will of Roanoke June 12, and 13, 1980.

The session opened with the song, "Victory in Jesus". The singing was led by James Myers with Donna Crabtree at the piano.

Rev. Jim Cox, pastor of the host church, gave the association a warm welcome. The clerk gave the response and introduced the officials of the association concluding with the moderator, Jack Stallings, who gave his remarks after reading from II Peter, 3:10-12. He then proceeded to appoint the committees. The Registration Committee was Jim Cox, Glenda Cox, and Betty Cardwell. The Nominating Committee was Dale Burden, J. E. Estep and Kyle Sexton.

The hymn, "Lily of the Valley" was sung by the congregation and the Catron Family Singers blessed the conference with the songs, "Come Morning", "He Rows Me Over the Tide", and "I Forgive."

The moderator introduced the speaker of the evening, Rev. Dale Burden. Bro. Burden brought a very inspiring message using Scripture from Phil. 1:19 and for a text "The preacher must be a man of prayer." He spoke of Paul's prayer life and that John the Baptist taught his disciples to pray. He concluded with an altar call to a more dedicated prayer life. Prayer was led by Wilton Dail and concluded by J. E. Estep. The evening service closed with the hymn, "Old-time Power".

FRIDAY MORNING

The conference opened with the congregation singing, "At Calvary". The singing was led by James Myers with Donna Crabtree at the piano. Prayer was offered by Bro. Hobart Addington.

The devotions were given by Bro. J. D. Kilgore. Using Scripture from Acts 2:42 he spoke of the need for prayer, the need for togetherness, and the fact that man's faith seems to have weakened.

Letters were read from the associations that had reported and were received as read and delegates were seated.

The following National reports were given: Foreign Mission report was given by Harold Critcher, the Home Mission's report was given by Bob Lewis, the Bible College report was given by Paul Kettleman, the Sunday School report was given by Harold Harrison, reports were sent from the Executive Office and the Master's Men.

The Nominating Committee recommended that the Superannuation Board consist of one member from each district and that each individual association present a nomination from their association. This was received by the body.

Margaret Merhk and Marvin Dodgins were elected to serve as delegates to the National. The Moderator was empowered to fill any vacancies from those present.

The Memorial Prayer was led by Paul Kettleman.

After the conference was adjourned the congregation sang, "Bless Be The Tie That Binds" and gave a rising vote of thanks to the host Church.
