

43rd SESSION PROCEEDINGS

The 43rd session of the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptist convened with the First Free Will of Roanoke June 18, and 19, 1981.

The session opened with the song, "Send The Light". The singing was led by Eugene Waddel with Malcolm Frye at the piano.

Rev. Jim Cox, pastor of the host church, gave the association a warm welcome. The clerk gave the response and introduced the officials of the association concluding with the moderator, Jack Stallings, who gave his remarks after reading from Galatians 1:6 - 9. He then proceeded to appoint the committees. The Registration Committee was Jim Cox, Faye Sams, and Georgia Johnson. The Nominating Committee was Bob Lewis, J. D. Kilgore, and Walter Sumerlin.

The hymn, "We've a Story To Tell" was sung by the congregation and Malcolm Frye blessed the conference with the song, "I Have Been Born Again".

The moderator introduced the speaker of the evening, Rev. Don Pegram. Bro. Pegram brought a very inspiring message using Scripture from Luke 14:21-24 and Luke 17:11-19. He remarked that, "prayer is the work that takes the work out of work and makes it become a joy". He spoke of recovery, removal, and recruitment evangelism. The evening service closed with prayer by Melvin Worthington.

FRIDAY MORNING

The conference opened with the congregation singing, "At Calvary". The singing was led by James Myres with Malcolm Frye at the piano.

The devotions were given by Bro. Sigby Delta. Using Scripture from Psalms 78:32-39 he compared the days of Israel's apostasy to today.

Letters were read from the associations reporting and were received as read and delegates were seated.

Following a short break the congregation sang, "Love Lifted Me". Prayer was offered by Ralph Flanary. Special singing was offered by Malcolm Frye. The Morning Message was brought by Bro. Mike Messer using Scripture from Hebrew 9:11-15. He spoke of the past plan of redemption and the present plan of atonement. The Memorial Prayer was led by Walter Statzer. The host church received a vote of thanks. A motion was made and carried to adjourn.

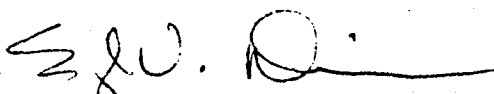
