50th SESSION PROCEEDINGS

The 50th session of the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptist convened with the First Free Will Baptist of Roanoke on Thursday evening June 16, 1988 at 7:30 p.m.

The welcome address was given by Jeff Crabtree, the host pastor. The response was given by the clerk, Lottie Cardwell. who then proceeded to introduce the officers concluding with the Assistant Moderator, Danny Baer, who served in the absence of the elected moderator. Prayer was offered by Wilton Dail.
