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52ND SESSION PROCEEDINGS

The 52nd session of the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the First Free Will Baptist Church of Roanoke on Thursday evening, June 14, 1990, at 7:30 p.m.

The session was opened by singing, "Dwelling in Beulah Land." Prayer was led by Walter Summers. The welcome was given by the host pastor, Jeff Crabtree. The welcome response was given by the clerk pro-tem James Myers, who then proceeded to introduce the officers, concluding with the Moderator, David Neitch.

The Moderator called the session to order for business, and proceeded to fill vacancies on boards. Eckel Herron was elected to the Executive Board in the absence of Raymond Baird.

The Moderator appointed the following to serve on the Nominating Committee: Jeff Crabtree, Chairman; John Burgess and E. T. Darnell. Those appointed to the Registration Committee were: Terry Beck, Chairman; J. D. Kilgore and Kyle Sexton. Those appointed to the Credentials Committee were: Dale Burden, Chairman; Dan Merkh and Sherman Grace. James Myers was elected clerk pro-tem for this session. While the congregation sang "When We All Get to Heaven," the offering of \$45.95 was received. Ralph Flanary gave thanks for the offering.

The worship service was opened by singing by the Youth Group from the Corner Stone Free Will Baptist Church of Bristol, Tennessee. The theme for that singing was "Happiness." Steve Flanary sang "Singing I Go." Brother Jennings Dotson read Ephesians 6, verses 16 and 17, and brought an inspired message on "The Shield of Faith and The Sword of the Spirit." Prayer of dismissal was given by E. T. Darnell.

The Friday morning session was opened by singing "Stand Up, Stand Up For Jesus." Devotions were given by Jeff Crabtree using the 11th chapter of St. Matthew, verses 28 and 29. The topic was "Jesus' Remedy for Rest."

Following the Moderator's remarks, Terry Beck was

elected Assistant Moderator for this session. The minutes of the last session were read for information. The report from the Credentials Committee was received and approved. All associations belonging to the Virginia State Association reported, the Moderator seated their delegates.

The following National Reports were received as information: Foreign Mission report was given by Jeff Crabtree; Home Mission report was given by David Neitch; Free Will Baptist Bible College report was given by Ronald Creech; Sunday School Department report was given by Terry Eagleton; Southwestern Bible College report was given by Danny Bare; National Office report was given by Melvin Worthington.

The morning worship was opened by singing "I Am Thine O Lord." Ralph Flanary presented special awards to Wilton Dail, Lottie Cardwell, and James Myers for their faithful services to the State Association. Jeff Skiles sang "Only Jesus and Calvary's Love." Darrell Pickle read verse 17 of the 6th chapter of Ephesians, and brought a wonderful message on "The Sword of the Spirit, Which is the Word of God." Ronald Creech led in the altar prayer of repentance. Prayer of dismissal and thanks for the food was given by Ralph Flanary.

The afternoon session was opened by singing "Amazing Grace." The clerk, James Myers, read from the 6th chapter of Jeremiah, verses 16 through 19, and chapter 18, verses 3 through 8, and Psalms 150 for devotions. His topic was "Let Everything That Has Breath Praise the Lord."
