Minutes of the First Central Quarterly Meeting when convened with the Harmony (St. C) Church on November 17th and 18th, 1867 at the Tabernacle in Benton.

Friday Evening 7:30 P.M.

Fifteen people present, service was opened by Singing At Calvary, He had prayer and then sang We Have An Anchor And Rock of Ages. Bro. Clifford Hicks read the 1st Chapter of 1st Timothy and gave some comments on it. He then conducted a very interesting Bible Quiz between the men and women. The men won. He sang another song and were dismissed in prayer by Bro. Johnny Holmes.

Saturday Morning Nov. 18 at 9:40 A.M.

Services were opened with Bro Hobart Conner praying. Bro. David Shores led the congregation in a song titled Dwelling In Bulk Land. Sister Pat Shores played the piano.

The clerk then introduced the Moderator, Rev. James Dite. After opening remarks the moderator called on Bro. Meredith Hilliard to give devotions. He used Hebrews 10, Verses 26 thru 29. He gave a very good devotion.

The clerk read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was seconded and carried to accept them as read. The clerk then read the church letters. The motion was seconded and carried to accept the letters as read and sent the delegates. There were 26

delegates and ten churches represented. A letter requesting dismissal was read from the Eakin Grove Church. A motion was given to grant the request of the Eakin Grove Church and the Clerk write them a letter telling them of the action of the Quarterly Meeting. The motion was seconded and carried. Bro. Loyd Lasley requested that the Quarterly Conference receive his ordination papers as the church of which he is a member is no longer a member of the State Association. The motion was then seconded and carried to accept his request and receive his papers.
