The meeting was called to order by the Clark.

reading the Church Covenant responsively.

The church letters were read, motion  
was made and sustained to accept the reading  
of the church letter and seat the delegates.

The moderator appointed the following committees.

Clark Lincoln, Everett Pearce, and Bob  
Jasper.

The treasurer report was given by Sister  
Ginger Kerr. The balance reported was \$439.22.

The treasurer report was given by Sister Ginger Kerr. Balance on Hand as of July 13<sup>th</sup> 1886 was \$ 500.00. Motion was made and sustained to accept the report as given. The Clerk read the minutes of the April 96 meeting. Motion was made and sustained to ~~to~~ accept the minutes as read. The Clerk announced that copies of the 1886 Free Will Baptist yearbook, 1886 minutes of the Illinois State association meeting and copies of the Illinois State Constitution were available for each church to pick up.

The moderator announced a short recess and Pastor Larry Cook began prayer.

The meeting was called back into order by the moderator, Bro Dan Martin. Pastor Kerr led the congregation in singing "Follow On". Pastor

Herr brought in a special. ~~Pastor~~ Pastor Bell Crank led in prayer. Brother David Shores brought the message using Ephesians 1: 1-14 and I Corinthians 6: 9-11 as ~~the~~ the text.

The following reports were given:

Memorial Committee - Request a time of silent prayer in memory of those who have passed on. From Hazel Dell - Betty Cockrum; from Rescue - Gethel Young; from Peace - Sue Ringo and Lucy Humphrey; and from Walltown - LaSue Marague. Request Bro David Baker close in prayer. Signed Sister Ruth Wells, Lela Shrum, and Bonnie Allu. Motion was made and sustained to accept the report. After a moment of silence Brother David Baker led in prayer.

Resolutions Committee - Whereas Disney Corporation has taken a stand in defiance of morality and families with its support of Homosexuality in its theme parks and corporate policies and whereas our quarterly Conference stands for the Word of God and the morality that our Lord teaches. Be it resolved that we encourage our member Churches to encourage their members to boycott Disney Corporation and its affiliates. A rising wedge church was given to the Presbyterian Church for hosting the meeting.

Business Committee - The business committee suggests that the Clerk make copies of the request submitted. Each copy should be sent to each church's pastor and each church member as needed. Letters received from Bill Clinton, Carol Mosely-Brown, Paul Simon, Jerry Costello, & Dick Durbin. Request is made along the lines of the testimony of Vicki Stello, who is in opposition to H.R. 1833/s.

The committee recommends that Bill Crank fill the unexpired term of Ed Shrum on the business committee. Signed Tracy Berry, Mark Shores, Ed Shrum. Motion was made and sustained to accept the report and act on each item individually. After some explanation of the letters received, motion was made and sustained to direct the Clerk to make ~~make~~ copies of each response and mail one copy to each Pastor. Motion was made and sustained to elect Bill Crank to the unexpired term of Ed Shrum on the Business Committee.

The asst moderator, David Malone, was asked to moderate the meeting. Brother Kerr led the congregation singing of "Let Just Praise the Lord." Brother Malone had a wonderful time of testimonies from the congregation. Special music was provided by Sister Sue King and the Masconotek quartet. The moderator made the following committee appointments: Resolutions Committee - Clark Lincoln, Wesley Conner, Daniel Barker, Memorial Committee - Thelma Wibb, Loraine Crank, Geraldine Lewis, Nominating Committee - Tom Harmon, Robert Irwin, Bob Jasper. Auditing Committee - Carolyn Irwin, Pat Peterson, Teri Schultz.

Sister Singer Herr gave the Treasurer's report showing a balance on hand as of Oct 19, 1886 of \$ 500.00. Motion was made and sustained to accept the report as given. The Clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. Motion was made and sustained to accept the minutes as read. Bro Tom Harmon led in prayer and the moderator announced a short recess.

The meeting was called back to order as Bro Marion Wells led in singing "Come and Dine" and "at Calvary". Brother David Malo sang a special "The Easter Hymn". Bob Jasper

led in prayer and Bro Malone introduced Rev Travis Penn as the first speaker. He chose his text from Jeremiah Chaps 7 & 8 and spoke on the subject "Worship, God in Preaching".

The following Committee reports were given:

Resolutions - Be it resolved, we give a rising vote of thanks to the Oak Grove FWB Church for hosting today's meeting. Signed Clark Lincoln, Wesley Conner, and David Baker. Motion was made and sustained to accept the report and the delegates stood in appreciation of the Oak Grove Church Memorial Committee.
