Following recess, Bro. and Sister Ham led our music service, and Bro. Robert Helms from the Berea Ministry preached for us from 2 Corinthians 6:11-13 about enlarging our hearts. He also presented a slide show of the work in Mexico, Chile and Costa Rico.
