Of Free Will Baptist churches
Saturday, February 6, 2016
Plano, Texas

The meeting was called to order by the moderator, Bro. Richard Rust. Those present were bro. Richard Rust, Bro. Clarence Hearron, Bennie Anderson, Bro. Barry Kelly, and the clerk, Thelma Terry. The meeting was opened with scripture reading, I Thessalonians 5:14. Bro. Bennie Anderson opened in prayer.

The minutes from the last meeting were read with MMC to accept the report as read.

The Treasurer's Report was read giving an ending balance in the check book of \$8,602.07 as of December 30, 2016. MMC to accept the report with a correction for the beginning date of the report as September 30, 2015 rather than the printed date, June 30, 2015.

Bro. Bennie Anderson gave the CE Board Report showing a balance in the check book of \$2,234.19. MMC to accept the report as read. Information was given regarding the 2016 camp year. The camp dates are June 20-24, 2016. Bro. Barry Kelly will be the Camp Director and Alan Jones will be the Evangelist. Bro. Bennie also reported that John Harris was putting a roof on the well house, but due to illness had been delayed, but would be completed in the near future.

Discussion was held concerning the vacancies left on the CE Board. Bro. Hearron pointed out that the board can temporarily appoint replacements until elections.

Discussion was held concerning a speaker for the yearly meeting in May. It was decided that Bro. Rust look into the idea of having someone from Hillsdale come, or see if there is a missionary on furlough that would be close enough to come, possibly one staying on the Hillsdale campus.

Discussion was held regarding the way preachers were accepted into the association, and that a new questionnaire and new forms be established to replace the old ones due to the situation at the Weatherford church.

Discussion was held concerning the Weatherford Church property remaining in the hands of people who do not conform to the Free Will Baptist Treatise. In order to be better informed, it was pointed out that we would need the church constitution for wording. It was decided that the Executive Board investigate the legal and Biblical means to handle the situation in a Biblical manner.

Conversation was had concerning the agenda of the Quarterly Conference Meeting. Since it seems sometimes difficult to arrange a speaker for the Workshop, it was agreed to suspend with having a workshop. The Board Meetings would start at 9:00 a.m., the Business Meeting would start at 11:00 a.m., and the Worship Service would start at 11:00 a.m. MMC to recommend the change to the body for vote.

West Fork District Business Meeting Minutes Of Free Will Baptist Churches

Saturday, February 6, 2016

Plano, Texas

Bro Robert Posner opened the Business Meeting with the welcome. Prayer requests were taken and Bro. Posner led in prayer.

The **Credentials Committee Report** was given by Bro. Tom Quinones, reporting receipt of nine (9) letters including the Weatherford Church with eight (8) dues received, Weatherford did not pay dues. It was also pointed out that a letter was in the mail and had not been received by the clerk at this date. The committee recommended accepting all letters except the one from Weatherford and seat the delegates. MMC to seat the delegates.

The **Minutes** were read from the last meeting, with MMC to accept the report. An amendment was added which stated Bro. Willard Kiper had been accepted into the West Fork Association in good standing. Carried.

The **Executive Board** had one item to be voted on.

Item #1

Recommend the West Fork District Meeting agenda change the meeting time to begin the board meetings begin at 9:00, the Business Meeting begin at 10:00 and the Worship Service begin at 11:00. We would no longer have a workshop. MM, 2nd, followed by discussion. It was decided that the workshop was important and enjoyed by many so Item #1 was voted down, the agenda will remain the same.

The **Financial Report** was given showing an ending check book balance of \$8,602.07 as of December 31, 2016. MMC to accept the report with a correction showing the beginning checkbook balance as of September 30, 2016 rather than the printed June 30, 2015.

Bro. Bennie Anderson gave the **CE Report** showing a current checkbook balance of \$2,234.19. He reported the campground caretaker had fallen behind in his rent, but the Pleasant Mound Church paid the balance to get him current. Bro. Bennie gave the current information regarding 2016 Camp year:

Bro. Richard Terry, representing the Credentials Committee reported that he spoke with the pastor of the Weatherford Church concerning their doctrinal issues regarding the Day of Worship and their decision to start worshiping on Saturday rather than Sunday. The clerk then received a letter from the church stating they would not conform to the

Free Will Baptist Treaties stating the accepted Day of Worship is Sunday. Due to their decision they would not be in fellowship with the West Fork Association, or the Free Will Baptist Association. Discussion was held concerning the Biblical and legal way to handle the situation to save the property for Free Will Baptist. Bro. Tom Quinones who is an attorney was asked to investigate the legal options and issues. He pointed out that we would need the churches By-Laws and Constitution. Since it had already been voted to allow the Executive Committee to follow-up on the matter, no action was taken at this time. They will follow-up and report back to the body. It was pointed out that above all, prayer and Biblical teachings be considered before any steps taken.

Item # 1

MMC that the Executive Committee and Bro. Tom Quinones meet with the Weatherford church after all information received and discussed, and get back to the body.

Item #2

MMC not to receive the Weatherford letter till this issue is settled.

Item #3

MMC to appoint the Executive Committee to revise the pastor and deacon questionnaire and report back to the conference.

That any and all ordination credentials be annulled and void.

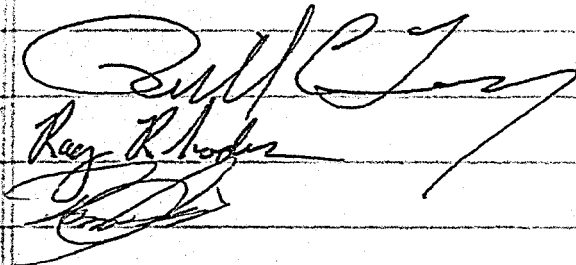
