13. Visitors were recognized. Granted all privileges except voting. At this time the moderator recognized Rev. E. Vincent, Rev. G. Pugh and Rev. G. Poston.
 14. Clerk read the minutes of September 13, 1986. Motion by Rev. Hopkins to accept as read and was second by Rev. Halbrook.
 15. Treasurer report read by sister L. Hopkins. The balance as of December 12, 1986 was \$333.52. Motion by Bro. B. Johnson to accept and second by Bro. Lasseter.
