Credential Committee elected as follows: Rev. J. W. Cooper, Rev. Arlie Joe Ball, Rev. Nolan Holstein.

Obituary Committee elected as follows: Rev. Luther Ray Morgan, Rev. Brooks Spurlock, and Sis. Arlie Joe Ball to serve 1, 2, 3 years as named above.

Next Session Committee elected: Bro. George Parsons, Sis. Bonn'e Lou Henson, and Sis. Ada Raines.

Motion and second that we refer to the Business Committee the question whether the Obituary Committee be a standing board or an elected committee. Carried.

Since the present treasurer for the Orphanage Board was absent, motion and second that we suspend the rules of order to elect a treasurer for this board. Carried. Rev. D. W. French was nominated. Motion, second, and carried to close nominations and elect by acclamation.

Motion and second that we adjourn for preaching. Carried.

Motion and second due to Rev. Truman Collier's leaving the state to obtain employment, his place be declared vacant on League Board. Carried.

Rev. Billy Samms nominated to fill his unexpired term. Motion and second that we close nominations and elect by acclamation. Carried.

Motion and second we elect a committee of three to meet with the Beckley Conference Executive Board or Trustee Board to make an inquiry about the purchasing the camp site for the State Association. Carried.

Motion and second that the League Board serve as this special committee for the buying or contracting the camp site. Carried.

Report of the Foreign Mission Board chairman, Rev. Carl Vallance. A wonderful report was given, but it could have been much better. Motion and second to accept same. Carried.

Report of Home Mission Board chairman, Rev. Ernold Barker, and Rev. John H. Henson. Motion, second, and carried to accept same.

Report of Credential Committee by chairman:

Item No. 1: We recommend that the state clerk instruct Elk River Conference clerk to send names of clerks of each church and addresses immediately and after this be sure to include their names and addresses in letter to State Association each year. Carried.

Item No. 2: Print names of ministers without Beckley Conference addresses, but clerk instruct their clerk about including them hereafter. Carried.

Item No. 3: We recommend State Clerk to instruct Wyoming Conference clerk to send church and clerks names and addresses and include same each year.

Item No. 4: We recommend state clerk to return \$40.00 to the Lincoln County Conference for money overdue.

Item No. 5: We recommend clerk to instruct McDowell County Conference clerk to send list of churches and names and addresses of clerks to state clerk.

Item No. 6: We recommend that each conference clerk write out letter to State Association and have them typed or write them in a legible manner before sending them to state clerk. Carried.

Report of Superannuation Board as follows:

"We find that superannuation has been greatly neglected in our state. The National Association asks that every state have a state superannuation board and that they work in harmony in the state with their state set-up to raise money for this purpose.

"This board is to keep 75% of what it raises to give monthly checks to the man who is already worn out or afflicted and send 25% of what it raises to the national superannuation board to help carry on this work.

"We have a plan to endow the minister between 21 and 55 with \$2,000.00 to start with, and then more, as we can get our people to help. Where the minister has, or wants this endowment, we ask his church or churches to send as much to the board direct to the National Board of Superannuation, 3801 Richland Avenue, Nashville 5, Tennessee as half of his premium. Thus the minister will pay half to the board and his church will pay half of his endowment to the board.

"We have endowed almost half as many ministers since January, 1956 as had been endowed in all the life of this program by the National Board.

Brethren, if a man, who has worked on the railroad, served in army or navy, worked for a corporation, or any other field, is worthy of a pension, why not the man who married you, led you to Christ, baptized you, preached your loved one's funeral, loved you, and helped you in your sorrow—why isn't he worthy of a pension when he is old?

We had Rev. K. V. Shutes, our National Secretary of Superannuation, to tour the state from April 7 to 26 to help sell our people on this work. He had many successful services and some discouraging ones. He received \$272.98 for National Superannuation and urged every church to send offerings as often as they will to Rev. Frank Johnson, Lenore, West Virginia. The state board can start giving monthly checks to the brethren who need it now, as soon as you make it possible.

"We, the State Board of Superannuation, recommend that each church send \$3.00 to each Quarterly Meeting for superannuation and the treasurer of the Quarterly Meeting send it to Rev. Frank Johnson, Lenore, West Virginia. He is treasurer of the board."

Item No. 6: We recommend that the Greenbrier-Nicholas Conference letter be accepted and delegates be seated. Carried.

Item No. 7: We recommend that a sum of seventy-five dollars be given to the clerk for her work. Carried.

Item No. 8: We recommend that 1200 minutes be printed with the program. Carried.

Item No. 9: We recommend that a Sunday School Board be set up in our State Association to work in this ripe field. Carried.

Item No. 10: We recommend that we adopt the recommendations of the Executive Secretary of the State Association. Carried.

Item No. 11: We recommend that the Executive Secretary be given \$100.00 for his services. Carried.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

Recommendations to the State Association of Free Will Baptists when assembled in regular session June 8 and 9, 1956.

I recommend that the State Association adopt the cooperative plan of giving and that the State Budget be set at \$19,000 for the fiscal year to be used as follows:

National Foreign Missions.....	\$2,500
Christian Education.....	2,500
Orphanage	3,000
Local Home Missions.....	8,000
National Home Missions.....	1,000
National Headquarters Fund.....	2,000

I further recommend that all money raised for any phase of the work be sent into one central state treasury and that any designated money raised for any specific purpose be deducted from the amount set forth in the budget.

In order to raise the proposed State Budget, I recommend that each board member of all standing boards including executive board put forth efforts to raise the budget. I further recommend that all pastors urge their churches to tithe their total income and send to state treasurer.

I further recommend that two home mission stations be set up—one at Summersville, W. Va., and one at Clay, W. Va., since these are two of the most strategic points as almost all of our work is in the southern part of the state and the field is white ready to be harvested.

I further recommend that we have one home mission worker for the entire state.

I further recommend that a prayer week be designated as of November 18, 1956 and continue through November 24, 1956, and that all churches in the state make it their business to pray, thank God for past blessings, and seek His face for future blessings and guidance.

The planning board was elected as follows: Moderator, Rev. G. E. Pauley; Chairman of the Executive Board, Rev. Nolan Holstein; and Treasurer, Brother Glen Miller.

Motion and second that we recommend a chairman from each board to be named and sent to the National Association as state directors for each board. Carried.

Special song by Rev. and Mrs. Arlie Joe Ball while an offering was taken for orphans home—the amount \$24.00.

Delegates named to National Association:

CONSTITUTION OF STATE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE NO. 1

This Association shall be known as the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists.

ARTICLE NO. 2

The object of this organization shall be to more thoroughly unify the work of the Free Will Baptist of the state of West Virginia and to advise and execute measures for the extension of the Kingdom of Christ and for the salvation of souls in connection with the various Quarterly or Yearly Meetings comprising this state association.

ARTICLE NO. 3

The membership of this State Association shall consist of the Quarterly Meetings and district association or yearly meetings that from time to time upon approval shall become members of this body.

ARTICLE NO. 4—Discipline

The State Association shall have the right to settle any questions of discipline, doctrine or usage that may properly come before it from time to time, from any quarterly meetings or yearly meetings composing the said State Association, or act upon any appeal that may be made by any of the bodies that belong to the State Association. The said appeal shall have been written and signed by the Association making the appeal, then forwarded by mail or in person to State Association and Quarterly Meeting.

ARTICLE NO. 5—Officers

The officers of the State Association shall be a Moderator and Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, each of whom shall be nominated before the floor and elected by a standing vote, from the floor, at each regular meeting provided, however, that the Moderator shall not be elected two years in succession from the same quarterly meeting or yearly meeting except in case of necessity. Election shall be determined by a majority vote of those persons and officers thus elected who shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and installed. (Vote unanimous).

ARTICLE 6—Executive Board

The Executive Board shall be composed of the following: The moderator, the Secretary, the Treasurer of the State Association, and one representative from each Quarterly Meeting.

ARTICLE 7—Boards And Committees

All Standing Boards shall be composed of three members to be elected as follows: The first named for the term of one year, the second for a term of two years, the third named for a term of two years, the third named for a term of two years, the fourth named for a term of three years in succession to office thereafter shall be determined as order required. Standing Boards include the Foreign Mission, Home Mission, the Board of Education, the Board of Superannuation, a Free Will Baptist League, and a Woman's Auxiliary Board and a Sunday School Board.

Section 2—The duties of the various boards shall be to plan a program and supervise its operation in their respective fields. They shall organize themselves and regulate their work as may become necessary, and may be found in harmony with the principles and tenets of the State Association.

Section 3—This State Association shall have as many committees as it is necessary to carry out the program that it may determine to promote.

ARTICLE 8—Dues

Annual dues shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per each Quarterly Meeting that is represented to this State Association plus (\$2.00) for each church belonging to the Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting composing this body.

ARTICLE 9

Section 1—All ordained ministers, deacons, and delegates shall voice and vote that are represented by their Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting to this body.

Section 2—Each Quarterly Meeting shall have one delegate for each church belonging to it.

ARTICLE 10—Meetings

This State Association shall hold its regular meetings annually on Friday and Saturday before the second Sunday in June at a place fixed by the regular session and made known before adjournment. Special meetings may be called by the Executive Board when extreme necessity demands, provided that the clerks of each Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting has been properly notified fifteen days before the date of the meeting. Twenty-five legal representatives shall constitute a quorum for any special or regular meeting of this organization.

Article 11—Trustees

This State Association shall have a Board of Trustees, consisting of five members, each of whom shall be nominated from the floor, elected by a standing vote, two-thirds of all voting members shall be final. This Board shall receive property only at the order of the State Association, it shall be a permanent Board unless body sees fit to discontinue.

ARTICLE 12—Duties Of Officers

It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside at all meetings to see to it that all the Constitution and the By-Laws are obeyed and respected, and to exercise all the rights of any other member except the right to vote. The right to vote shall only be given the Moderator in case of a tie. He shall be allowed to speak on any subject provided the Assistant is in the chair. He shall not speak at any other time except in way of explanation. It shall be the duty of the Assistant Moderator to assist the Moderator in any way that he can in the discharge of his duty.

This duty shall not be construed to abridge his right to vote when in the chair, in which he shall be governed by same rule as effecting the Moderator.

It shall be the duty of the clerk to keep a complete record of all meetings, to publish same in book form, minuted and distribute to the various Quarterly Meetings or Yearly Meetings composing this State Association. All expenses of such records and printing to be defrayed by the treasury.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to hold and keep all such money as may come into the State Association and disburse it only at the direction of proper authorities. He shall make a bond of not less than all funds coming into his possession.

ARTICLE 13—Licensing And Ordaining

Section 1—No man, having been divorced and remarried or having married a divorced woman, shall be licensed or ordained to preach or for deacons.

Section 2—No woman shall be ordained or licensed to preach or usurp authority over men.

ARTICLE 14—Amendments

This Constitution may be amended at any regular session of the State Association by a two-thirds vote of all members present provided the changes are recommended in writing at least one day before the vote is taken.

BY-LAWS

A portion of the scripture shall be read and prayer shall be offered at the beginning of each morning and afternoon sessions of the State Association and prayer shall be offered at the close of each session.

2—The Moderator or Assistant Moderator shall call the meeting to order at the hour designated by the program committee. When neither the Moderator or Assistant is present the Executive Board shall elect a Moderator pro tem who shall call the meeting to order.

3—It shall be the duty of the Clerk to call the names of delegates, ministers, and deacons at the beginning of each session and assess them one dollar (\$1.00) each; who shall present themselves with proper evidence of their rights to seats therein and those enrolled by the Clerk shall compose the State Association.

4—It shall be the duty of the Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting or Associations so composing this Organization to send a letter to it giving as accurately as possible the information requested by the National Association. In their letter forms published by the Free Will Baptist Gem Monett Mo.

5—Not over one deacon shall be appointed on any one committee.

6—Only ordained ministers shall be allowed to moderate this meeting.

7—All Sunday Schools and young people's leagues and Women's Auxiliaries shall work in their own bodys and report to State Association.

8—In case of any controversy regarding parliamentary procedure, Robert's Rules of Order shall be considered as final authority.

9—All business except routine shall be brought before this body by committee but should the committee refuse or fail to present to this body any business given it by any member of this State Association, then such business may be presented by any member of the body, but cannot be discussed unless by vote of this body.

10—No one shall speak for more than five minutes or more than twice on the same subject without the consent of the Moderator.

11—That each conference have their letter and finance sent to the State Association clerk one week before the State Association convenes.

12—Any members of this body can appeal from the decision of the Moderator to the body and by a majority vote thereon, the objection shall be sustained or rejected.

13—No one shall leave the body without the consent of the Moderator.

14—Anyone desiring to speak shall arise and say Brother Moderator, but shall not speak further until he or she is recognized by the Moderator.

15—The Moderator shall stop all discussion when not carried on in a Christian Spirit, or when he thinks it will lead to discord or division.

16—This State Association shall correspond by messenger or otherwise to other religious bodies.

17—The same person or group of persons shall not serve on more than one standing board or committee as long as it can be supplied otherwise.

18—Not less than three Gospel Sermons shall be preached at any one session of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists.

19—These By-Laws may be revised or changed at any regular session of the State Association provided that they be plainly written and stated one day before the vote is taken.
