CONSTITUTION OF STATE ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE NO. 1

This Association shall be known as the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists.

ARTICLE NO. 2

The object of this organization shall be to more thoroughly unify the work of the Free Will Baptists of the state of West Virginia and to advise and execute measures for the extension of the Kingdom of Christ and for the salvation of souls in connection with the various Quarterly or Yearly Meetings comprising this state association.

ARTICLE NO. 3

The membership of this State Association shall consist of the Quarterly Meetings and district association or yearly meetings that from time to time upon approval shall become members of this body.

ARTICLE NO. 4 — Discipline

The State Association shall have the right to settle any questions of discipline, doctrine or usage that may properly come before it from time to time, from any quarterly meetings or yearly meetings composing the said State Association, or act upon any appeal that may be made by any of the bodies that belong to the State Association. The said appeal shall have been written and signed by the Association making the appeal, then forwarded by mail or in person to State Association and Quarterly Meeting.

ARTICLE NO. 5 — Officers

The officers of the State Association shall be a Moderator and Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer and Promotional Secretary. Each of whom shall be nominated from the floor and elected by a standing vote from the floor, at each regular session, except the Treasurer shall be elected for a Three Year period, beginning with the 23rd Session, providing however that the Moderator shall not be elected two years in succession from the same Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting, except in case of necessity.

Election shall be determined by a majority vote. Those persons and officers thus elected shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and installed.

ARTICLE NO. 6 — Executive Board

The Executive Board shall be composed of the following: The Moderator, the Clerk, the Treasurer of the State Association, and four (4) elected members, and not more than one (1) from any one Conference.

ARTICLE NO. 7 — Boards and Committees

All Standing Boards shall be composed of three (3) members to be elected as follows: the first named for the term of three years; the second for a term of two years; the third for a term of one year, in order that, once the Board is set up, there will be one vacancy each year to fill, for a term of three years. Standing Boards include Foreign Mission, Home Mission, Board of Education, Orphanage Board, Christian Training Service (C. T. S.), Woman's Auxiliary Board and Sunday School Board.

Section 2—The duties of the various boards shall be to plan

a program and supervise its operation in their respective fields. They shall organize themselves and regulate their work as may become necessary, and may be found in harmony with the principles and tenets of the State Association.

Section 3—This State Association shall have as many committees as it is necessary to carry out the program that it may determine to promote.

ARTICLE NO. 8 — Dues

Annual dues shall be Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per each Quarterly Meeting that is presented to the State Association, plus Three dollars (\$3.00) for each church belonging to the Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting composing this body.

ARTICLE NO. 9

Section 1—All ordained ministers, deacons, and delegates shall voice and vote that are represented by their Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting to this body.

Section 2—Each Quarterly Meeting shall have one delegate for each church belonging to it.

ARTICLE NO. 10 — Meetings

This State Association shall hold its regular meetings annually on Friday and Saturday before the second Sunday in June at a place fixed by the regular session and made known before adjournment. Special meetings may be called by the Executive Board when extreme necessity demands, provided that the clerks of each Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting have been properly notified fifteen days before the date of the meeting. Twenty-five legal representatives shall constitute a quorum for any special or regular meeting of this organization.

ARTICLE NO. 11 — Trustees

This State Association shall have a Board of Trustees, consisting of five members, each of whom shall be nominated from the floor, elected by a standing vote. Two-thirds of all voting members shall be final. This board shall receive property only at the order of the State Association. It shall be a permanent Board unless body sees fit to discontinue.

ARTICLE NO. 12 — Duties of Officers

It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside at all meetings to see to it that all the Constitution and the By-Laws are obeyed and respected, and to exercise all the rights of any other member except the right to vote. The right to vote shall only be given the Moderator in case of a tie. He shall be allowed to speak on any subject provided the Assistant is in the chair. He shall not speak at any other time except in way of explanation. It shall be the duty of the Assistant Moderator to assist the Moderator in any way that he can in the discharge of his duty. This duty shall not be construed to abridge his right to vote when in the chair, in which he shall be governed by same rule as affecting the Moderator.

It shall be the duty of the Clerk to keep a complete record of all meetings, to publish same in book form, minuted and distributed to the various Quarterly Meetings or Yearly Meetings composing this State Association. All expenses of such records and printing to be defrayed by the treasury.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to hold and keep all such money as may come into the State Association and disburse

it only at the direction of proper authorities. He shall make a bond of not less than all funds coming into his possession.

I. PROMOTIONAL DIRECTOR

It shall be the duty of the Promotional Director to strive for the enlistment of new conferences and associations into the membership of the West Virginia Association. Also to promote the work of Free Will Baptists in new fields. The office of Promotional Director shall not be used to settle disputes between brethren and conferences. This office shall be supported by the Executive Department.

II. THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

It shall be the duty of the Executive Board to prepare the Program of the State Association. The Program shall be prepared by the Executive Board at a time designated by the Clerk and Moderator. The Executive Board shall act as an arbitration committee when called.

This committee shall be composed of not less than five (5) members of the Executive Board and they shall not be from the same conference, when the clerk and moderator requests.

III. FOREIGN MISSION BOARD

It shall be the duty of this board to cooperate with the Foreign Mission Board of the National Association of Free Will Baptist, and to endeavor to raise funds for the Foreign Mission work of our denomination. This board shall organize within itself with a Chairman and a Secretary-Treasurer. All money for Foreign Missions shall be sent to the Chairman of the Foreign Mission Board. This board shall arrange for missionary conferences throughout the State work as it feels necessary.

IV. HOME MISSION BOARD

This board shall organize within itself and elect a chairman and a secretary-treasurer. It shall be the duty of the Home Mission Board to promote the establishing of new churches and conferences throughout the State of West Virginia where we do not have established Free Will Baptist work. Sixty per cent of all money raised by the Home Mission Board shall be used in the promotional work of our own state and forty per cent shall be channeled to the National Home Mission Board.

V. ORPHANAGE BOARD

This Board shall maintain a relationship with the Free Will Baptist Home of Children at Greenville, Tennessee, and help provide for its support. One member of this board shall be a trustee of the Board of Trustees of the Free Will Baptist Home for Children at Greenville, Tennessee. Expenses of this trustee shall be provided for each official visit to the Home, not to exceed Twenty dollars (\$20.00). This board shall raise money for and relate its work with a Treasurer, Soliciting Member and Director and a Trustee.

VI. BOARD OF CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

This board shall organize within itself with a Chairman, Secretary and soliciting member. The duties of this board shall consist of: The enlightenment of the Free Will Baptist of West Virginia to the cause of the denomination and to publish tracts and help in the financial support of the students at Free Will Bible College; also help in the support of the Bible College itself. This

board shall endeavor to meet the quota set for the Bible College for our state.

All funds raised for this work shall be divided — 40 per cent to the Bible College and 40 per cent to the students that attend the Bible College at Nashville, Tennessee and 20 per cent for operating expenses.

This board shall provide funds only as they are available to the support of students. Any student willing to receive support from this board must be a Free Will Baptist and be in good standing in some church within the bounds of the State Association. They must also be recommended by their Church and Pastor.

VII. AUXILIARY BOARD

It shall be the duty of this board to promote the work of the Woman's Auxiliary in our state. This board may be composed of three women interested in this work.

VIII. CHRISTIAN TRAINING SERVICE

This board shall organize within itself with Chairman and Secretary-Treasurer. This board shall promote the Free Will Baptist C. T. S. in our state and endeavor to get District and State C. T. S. into their proper place in our churches and conferences.

IX. SUNDAY SCHOOL BOARD

This board shall organize within itself and have a Chairman and Secretary-Treasurer. This board shall endeavor to co-ordinate the Sunday School work in West Virginia and try to bring our Sunday Schools up to National Standards for Sunday Schools. The board shall endeavor to establish a Workers' Conference in our Sunday Schools and to work for the improvement of Sunday School literature and to help in establishing Teachers' Training Courses in our schools. These Schools shall be taught by those who have Evangelical Teachers' Training Association Certificates or are otherwise qualified. This board shall seek to establish a Sunday School Board in each Conference and shall be responsible for the over-all planning of Sunday School work in the State Association.

ARTICLE 13 — Licensing And Ordaining

Section 1—No man, having been divorced and remarried or having married a divorced woman, shall be licensed or ordained to preach or for deacons.

Section 2—No woman shall be ordained or licensed to preach or usurp authority over men.

ARTICLE 14 — Amendments

This Constitution may be amended at any regular session of the State Association by a two-thirds vote of all members present provided the changes are recommended in writing at least one day before the vote is taken.

BY-LAWS

1—A portion of the Scripture shall be read and prayer shall be offered at the beginning of each morning and afternoon sessions of the State Association and prayer shall be offered at the close of each session.

2—The Moderator or Assistant Moderator shall call the meeting to order at the hour designated by the Program Committee. When neither Moderator or Assistant is present the Executive Board shall elect a Moderator pro tem who shall call the meeting to order.

3—It shall be the duty of the Clerk to enroll the names of delegates, ministers and deacons at the beginning of each session and assess them one dollar (\$1.00) each; who shall present themselves with proper evidence of their rights to seat therein and those enrolled by the Clerk shall compose the State Association.

4—It shall be the duty of the Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting or Associations so composing this Organization to send a letter to it giving as accurately as possible the information requested by the National Association.

5—Not over one deacon shall be appointed on any one committee.

6—Only ordained ministers shall be allowed to moderate this meeting.

7—All Sunday Schools and Young Peoples' C. T. S. and Woman's Auxiliaries shall work in their bodies and report to State Association.

8—In case of any controversy regarding parliamentary procedure, Robert's Rules of Order shall be considered as final authority.

9—All business except routine shall be brought before this body by committee but should the committee refuse or fail to present to this body any business given it by any member of this State Association, then such business may be presented by any member of the body, but cannot be discussed unless by vote of this body.

10—No one shall speak for more than five minutes or more than twice on the same subject without the consent of the Moderator.

11—That each conference have their letter and finance sent to the State Association clerk one week before the State Association convenes.

12—Any member of this body can appeal from the decision of the Moderator to the body and by a two-thirds majority vote of all members present, thereon. This decision shall be sustained or rejected.

13—No one shall leave the body without the consent of the Moderator.

14—Anyone desiring to speak shall arise and say Brother Moderator, but shall not speak further until he or she is recognized by the Moderator.

15—The Moderator shall stop all discussion when not carried on in a Christian Spirit, or when he thinks it will lead to discord or division.

16—This State Association shall correspond by messenger or otherwise to other religious bodies.

17—The same person or group of persons shall not serve on more than one standing board or committee as long as it can be supplied otherwise.

18—Not less than three Gospel Sermons shall be preached at any one session of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists.

19—No person shall be elected to any office without being present.

20—These By-Laws may be revised or changed at any regular session of the State Association provided that they be plainly written and stated one day before the vote is taken.

21—The Moderator shall be elected at the close of each session on Saturday, who shall serve until his successor be elected at the same time the following year.

Minutes of the 23rd Session of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptist, while in session with the Marrowbone Free Will Baptist Church, Kermit, W. Va.

9:15 A. M.—Devotional by Rev. Frank Damron.

Song and Scripture Lesson followed by Alter of Prayer, lead by John Snodgrass.

Address of Welcome by Rev. Walter Raines.

Response by Rev. Frank Wiley.

M&S by Rev. Carl Vallance. That we adopt the program, and allow the moderator to make any necessary changes needed through out the session, carried.

Rev. McGraw, Chairman of the Credentials Committee made the following report. 17 conferences reporting, with 376 ministers and 145 churches, 7,648 members, and 23 licensee ministers, with a Sunday School enrollment of 9,937 pupils, and church valuation \$1,730,020.00, this report was received by motion and second, two letters was left in the hands of the Executive Board for their disposal, which was Lincoln Conference and Spruce Valley, after being handled by the Bussiness Committee, on Saturday the Moderator ruled that the decision of the association regarding the letter from Spruce Valley was out of order and there delegates were seated.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Rev. T. C. Morgan was elected by aclimation as Clerk.

Rev. Frank Wiley was elected as Treasurer, but later resigned in favor of Rev. Albert Halbrook.

Rev. William Sams was elected over Rev. Jerry McGraw as Promotional Director.

Rev Albert Halbrook was elected as General Board Member for the years 1969 and 1970.

M&S to allow the Moderator to appoint a Parliamentarian for the day. Carried. Rev. Carl Vallance was appointed.

Adjourned for Devotional Service.

Rev. Carl Vallance lead the Devotional and offering was lifted for the C. T. S. Board, Rev John Snodgrass prayed the Offertory Prayer, Alter of Prayer, Scripture read 1 Cor. 14 ch., 1-11 verses.

Morning Message by Rev. T. C. Morgan, using for a theme, Prepare for Battle. Song and Alter Call was given no response.

Lunch was served by the Ladies of the church in the church dining room.

1:00 P. M. — Devotional Leader Rev. Giles, Song and Prayer by Rev. Robert Shockey of The National Home Mission Board, Scripture Lesson read, Song. Business Committee gave a Parshel Report at this time. M&S to receive their report and act to them by item, Carried.

ITEM NO. 1 This item was broken down to Item A and B.

A. — We recommend that the State Association pay for the printing of the minutes in booklet form, Rec. by M&S.

B. — We also recommend hat each conference and church send a free will offering to the Clerk, Rev. T. C. Morgan, 1228 28th Street East, Huntington, West Virginia 25705, by September 15th 1968, this item was received by M&S to help pay for printing of minutes.

ITEM NO. 2 We recommend hat the Morning Star F. W. B. Church return to the Coal River Conference and receive a proper letter of dismissal before being excepted into the Spruce Valley Conference. This item was received by M&S&.

ITEM A OF THE NO. 2, we recommend that the entire report of the Spruce Valley Conference be placed into the hands of the State Executive Board for further disposition of all matters which has been presented to the State Association, received by M&S.

ITEM NO. 3 We recommend that Article No. 5 — officers, be changed. Where by the Treasurer would be elected for a period of three (3) years. Due to the necessitating a change in the Constitution this item was tabled till on Saturday, when it was received by motion and second.

There was an amendment made to Item No. 1 under B to read as follows: That if any money received over and above the price of printing of the Minutes to be turned over to the Publishing Board to be used by them. Carried.

Rev. William P. Vance gave a brief report on Foreign Mission, after whichh Rev. Carl Vallance gave the following report: That we were under our quota of \$16,250.00 by \$3,013.79 as of April this year. We have 78 missionaris, beside children in the fields, given in the U. S. through March 1, \$1,36,427.29, which is behind National Budget \$18,550.62, we needed through April \$66,997.95 for to put us up to date with our National budget. This report was received by M&S. Each board was filled after their report, and theywill be listed with the board's.

M&S at this time to lay plans that by this time next year we raise \$6,000.00 over and above our National quota. For the purpose

of placing a full time Foreign Mission worker in the W. Va. field. Carried.

Reprt of Home Mision Board by Rev. Lonnie Nelson. Paid out \$292.96 and had a balance of \$304.00 on hand, report was received by M&S. Rev. Bob Shockey of The National Home Mission Board gave a report on the National work, offering was taken for this dept. in the amount of \$50.00. Report was received by M&S.

Rev. John Henson gave report of the State Paper, printed last year 21,600 copys of the paper, at a cost of arroximately \$2.124 00 and had on hand at this time a balance of \$549.71, he mailed 1,520 copys each month. M&S to give a rising vote of thanks and receive this report, Carried.

Amendment to motion made to allow 7 cents per mile for all miles traveled last year, based on 150 each month, this motion and amendment carried.

Motion and second to elect Rev. John Henson as our State Paper Editor. Vote carried.

Business Committee reports ITEMS 4 through 7 for approval.

ITEM NO. 4 — We recommend that the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptist report to the National Association by letter and proper finance, item carried.

ITEM NO. 5 — We recommend hat the association pay Rev. Carl Vallance \$75.00 expenses as our General Board Member to the National Association, item carried.

ITEM NO. 6 — We recommend that the association give Rev. John Henson \$75.00 for his service as Promotional Director, item carried.

ITEM NO. 7 — We recommend that the State Executive Committee, Clerk, Moderator, Promotional Director, and Treasurer meet after the Saturday session of the association, and prepare he program for the following year, carried.

Rev. Vallance was called to the Chair and Rev. William Samms moved that we take from the Treasurer the sum of \$25.00 to pay the Saturday morning speaker, Item carried.

Motion to adjourn till 9:00 A. M. Saturday morning. Carried.

The Friday nite service was lead by Rev. Giles, and the Rev. Bob Shockey brought the evening message, which was wonderful received by those present. Benediction by Rev. T. C. Morgan.

SATURDAY MORNING JUNE 8TH 1968

9:00 A. M. Devotional Service by Rev. Nolan Webb. After song and fellowship hand shake we had prayer around the altar, lead by Brother John George, Scripture read, and service was given to Modertor, Called to order at 9:15 A. M.

Report of Promotional Director Rev. John Henson preached 111 sermons, 5 revivals, 9 confessions, 4 funerals, 2 weddings, received \$866.02 for services, and my expense was \$459.55. I have visited 13 conferences, attended the National Association last year, and the State Sunday School Convention, the CTS Workshop, and the Meigs Ohio Conference, I submit the following item for your approval. There is a need for advancement for a office or Headquarters Building, and also a Book Store or Book Mobile to furnish good historical reading for our people, this report was received by Motion and Second.

The recommendation was received for discussion and disposition. Motion and second to place this item in the hands of a committee, carried, names of committee, Rev. Franklin Wiley, Rev. Carl Vallance, Brother Ralph Scarberry.
