"And In Hell" He Said - Luke 16:19, 31

- 19 There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:
- 20 And there was a certain begger named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,
- 21 And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

## CONSTITUTION OF THE WEST VIRGINIA STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS

#### **PREAMBLE**

Having received salvation through faith in Jesus Christ, and having been baptized as an outward sign of our separation from the world, and realizing the necessity of being identified with and sharing the fellowship of other believers, have joined ourselves to a local visible church, we do ordain this Constitution to unify the work of Free Will Baptists in the State of West Virginia, and to devise and execute measures for the extension of the Kingdom of Christ and for the salvation of souls in cooperation with the various quarterly or yearly meetings comprising this State Association. May God bless our labor.

#### Article No. 1

Section 1. All ordained ministers and deacons belonging to member quarterly meetings and district Associations shall make up the standing delegates to this State Association. Each quarterly meeting shall be permitted to send three lay delegates to the State Association plus one delegate from each Church composing that quarterly meeting.

Section 2. The membership of the State Association shall consist of the quarterly meetings and district Association or yearly meetings from time to time upon approval shall become members of this body.

Section 3. Any minister, deacon or delegate voting in State Association, must be a member of a church in good standing with the quarterly meeting recommending them from the State Association.

Section 4. This State Association shall be affiliated with the National Association of Free Will Baptists of the United States of America, and recognize the Treastise of faith and practice as our guideline for denominal fellowship, as long as they remain an independent denomination.

## Article No. 2 - Discipline

Section 1. The State Association shall have the right to settle any questions of discipline, doctrine or usage that may properly come before it from time to time, from any quarterly meetings or yearly meetings composing the said State Association or act upon any appeal that may be made by any of the bodies that belong to the State Association. The said appeal shall have been written and signed by the Association making the appeal then forwarded by mail or in person to State Association and Quarterly Meeting.

Section 2. No quarterly meeting shall license or ordain to preach or to serve as deacon any man having two living wives. No man having married a divorced woman shall be licensed or ordained to preach, or ordained as deacon in this State Association.

Section 3. No quarterly meeting shall license or ordain a woman to preach.

Section 4. No quarterly meeting shall be accepted or retained as a member that license or ordain Women to preach.

Section 5. The Executive Board shall investigate any charges, after they have been properly presented to the quarterly meeting of which the grieved party or parties are a member. Any charges presented to this State Association Executive Board for consideration must be presented in writing and signed by the person or persons, making the charges.

Section 6. The Executive Board shall be paid the rate of fifteen cents (15¢) per mile from home to destination and return to home when traveling on State Association official business. The party or parties requesting the Executive Board to meet with them, shall be responsible to pay their expenses.

#### Article 3

The officers of the State Association shall be a Moderator and Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer and Promotional Secretary and Parliamentarian. Each of whom shall be nominated from the floor, at each regular session, except the treasurer, who shall be elected for a three-year period, beginning with the 23rd session, and the Moderator, who will be elected for two year terms, and he can serve two terms for a period of four years, beginning with the 38th session.

Election shall be determined by a majority vote. Those persons and officers thus elected shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and installed.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside at all meetings to see to it that all the Constitution and By Laws are obeyed and respected, and to exercise all the right to vote.

The right to vote shall be given the Moderator only in case of a tie. He shall be allowed to speak on any subject provided the assistant is in the chair. It shall be the duty of the Assisitant Moderator to assist the Moderator in any way he can in the discharge of his duty. This duty shall not be construed to abridge his right to vote when in the chair, in which he shall be governed to the same rule as that affecting the Moderator.

It shall be the duty of the Clerk to keep a complete record of all meetings to publish in book form, minutes and distributed to various quarterly meetings composing this State Association. All expenses of such records and printing are to be defrayed by the treasury.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to hold and keep all such money as may come into the State Association and disburse it only at the direction of proper authorities. He shall make a bond of not less than all funds coming into his possession. An Assistant Treasurer will be elected to act in any absence of the Treasurer, or act of emergency.

- **I. Promotional Director** It shall be the duty of the Promotional Director to strive for the enlistment of new conferences and associations into membership of the West Virginia State Association. Also to promote the work of Free Will Baptist in new fields. The office of Promotional Director shall not be used to settle disputes between brethren and conferences. This office shall be supported by the Executive Board or Department.
- **II. The Executive Committee** The Executive Board shall act as the State Association when State Association is not in session, action subject to approval by State Association.

- III. That a Program Committee be elected on Friday Morning to prepare the program for the coming year. This committee shall act as a placement committee and shall comply with the Constitution in making their choice for the Church, where the State Association is to be held. This committee shall consist of two ordained ministers, one deacon, and four members of duly seated delegates. This committee shall prepare to report to the state Association by 1:45 P.M. Saturday afternoon.
- IV. The Missions Board This board is to be a six member board, and shall work to promote Foreign and Home Missions work throughout the State of West Virginia. This board shall cooperate with the Missions board of the National Association, and endeavor to raise funds for the Missions board of our denomination. This board shall arrange missionary conferences throughout the state work as it feels necessary. Also to promote new churches and conferences through the State of West Virginia where we do not have established Free Will Baptist work.
- V. Children's Home Board This Board shall maintain a relationship with the Free Will Baptist Home for Children at Greenville, Tennessee, and help provide for its support. The member of this board shall be a trustee of the Board of Trustees of the Free Will Baptist Home for Children at Greenville, Tennessee. Expenses of this trustee shall be provided for each official visit to the Home. He shall be paid One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per trip, not to exceed three trips a year. This Board shall raise money for and relate its work with a Treasurer, Soliciting Members and Director, and Trustee.
- VI. Christian Education Board This board shall consist of five (5) members elected for a term of five (5) years and elected as so that one member be elected annually. It shall organize within itself a chairman, secretary and treasurer. It shall be the duty of this Board to generally oversee the educational efforts of this Association. This would include but not be limited to (A) organize and conduct a State Bible Institute; (B) Establish Sunday Schools; (C) Promote Church Training Service (CTS) and generally oversee competitive events on the state and district levels.
- VII. Publication Board The Publication Board shall consist of Five (5) members, elected for a term of five (5) years and elected so that one member is elected annually. It shall be organized with an Editor, Associate Editor Treasurer and three Associate Editors. It shall be the duty of this board to publish a regular news publication concerning the

various ministries of Free Will Baptist in West Virginia and in the world. This board shall be limited to new equipment purchases of \$300.00 per year without approval of the Association or the executive Board.

#### Article No. 4 — Executive Board

The Executive Board shall be composed of one ordained minister from each Quarterly Conference that is in good standing with the State Association.

Section 2. If any member of the Executive Board is unable to attend, he must send a proxy in his place.

Section 3. At a regular scheduled session, the Saturday before the state meeting, this board shall hear the reports of all standing boards and officers. It shall serve as a budget committee and make recommendations as deemed pertinent to State Association.

#### Article No. 5 — Boards

The standing boards shall be the following, Foreign Mission, Home Mission, Children's Home Board, C.T.S. Board, Publication Board and the Board of Trustees.

#### Article No. 6

Annual dues shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per each Quarterly Meeting that is presented to the State Association, plus Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each church belonging to the Quarterly Meeting composing this body.

Section 2. All ministers, deacons and delegates shall pay Three Dollars (\$3.00) registration fee, with the exception of those ministers who are Sixty-Five years old, and older or disabled. One dollar to go to the Church, one dollar to go to the State Association, and one dollar to help pay the annual dues to the National Association.

Section 3. Any minister receiving a good standing card must pay his three dollar (\$3.00) registration fee. Each quarterly meeting is requested to collect this fee and send to State Association with their letter.

## Article No. 7

The State Association shall hold its regular meetings annually on

Friday and Saturday before the second Sunday in June at a place and date fixed by the regular session and made known before adjournment.

Special meetings may be called by the Executive Board when extreme necessity demands provided that the clerk of each quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting has been properly notified fifteen days before the date of the meeting of this organization.

Section 2. Any Quarterly Meeting or Church desiring the State Association meet with the body shall present in writing the seating capacity, the facilities for feeding, sleeping and parking.

#### Article No. 8

This Constitution may be revised or changed at any regular session of the West Virginia State Association provided the change is presented in writing and stated one day before vote is taken.

#### **BY-LAWS**

- 1. A portion of the Scripture shall be read and prayer be offered at the beginning of each morning and afternoon session of the State Association and prayer shall be offered at the close of each session.
- 2. The Moderator or Assistant Moderator shall call the meeting to order at the hour designated by the Program Committee. When Moderator nor assistant is present, the Clerk shall call the meeting to order and elect a Moderator-protem.
- 3. It shall be the duty of the Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting or Association so composing this organization to send a letter to it giving accurately as possible the information requested by the National Association.
- 4. Not over one deacon shall be appointed on any one committee. Except in case of emergency.
- 5. Only ordained ministers shall be allowed to moderate this meeting.
- 6. All Sunday School Conventions and State Women's Auxiliary Convention report to the State Association, and their report be received as information.
- 7. In case of any controversy regarding parliamentary procedure, Robert's Rules of Order shall be considered as final authority.
- 8. All business, except routine, shall be brought by committee but should the committee refuse or fail to present to this body any business given it by any member of this State Association, then such business may be discussed unless by vote of this body.
- 9. No one shall speak for more than five minutes or more than twice on the same subject without the consent of the Moderator.
- 10. Each conference shall have its letter and finance report sent to the State Association Clerk one week before the State Association convenes.

- 11. Any member of this body can appeal from the decision of the Moderator to the body and by two thirds majority of all members present, thereon. This decision shall be substained or rejected.
- 12. No one shall leave the body without the consent of the Moderator. Anyone deciding to speak shall arise and say "Brother Moderator" shall not speak further until he or she is recognized by the Moderator. The Moderator shall stop all discussion when not carried on in a Christian Spirit, or think it will lead to discord or division.
- 13. This State Association shall correspond by messenger or otherwise with other religious bodies.
- 14. The same person or group of persons shall not serve on more than one standing board or committee as long as it can be supplied otherwise.
- 15. Not less than three (3) Gospel Sermons shall be preached at any one session of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists.
- 16. No person shall be elected to any office without being present, except the Executive Board. (The member is recommended by the Quarterly Conference.)
- 17. The Moderator shall be elected at the close of each two year session on Saturday, and shall serve until his successor is elected at the same time the following two years.
- 18. No Ministers, Deacons or Delegates shall be permitted to vote that is a known Homosexual, Bi-Sexual or Lesbian in this State Association. The State Association will not retain any person or persons known to be as such.
- 19. The Officers of the State Association shall receive and honoraria as follows: Moderator \$35.00. Assistant Moderator \$15.00. Clerk \$100.00. Treasurer \$30.00.
- 20. The member of the General Board of the National Association shall receive \$250.00 when the National Association convenes East of the Mississippi River and \$350.00 West of the Mississippi River.
- 21. These By-Laws may be revised or changed at any regular session of the State Association provided that they be plainly written and stated one day before vote is taken.

Minutes of the 38th Annual Session of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists, held at the Central Free Will Baptist Church, June 10, 11, 1983, Huntington, W. Va.

#### FRIDAY MORNING SESSION

9:30 A.M. — Devotional by Rev. Carl Cooper Scripture was read and prayer was offered by Rev. Moss Craddock Address of Welcome — Rev. Carl Vallance Moderator — Rev. George Smith took charge.

Motion and second was made to accept program with any necessary changes to be made by the Moderator. Carried.

Credential Committee Report — The Credential Committee made the following recommendations;

Item No. 1. That we accept the letters from Beckley, Brotherhood, Christian Fellowship, Coal River, Elk River, Fayette, Greenbrier County, Greenbrier Nicholas, Guyan Valley, Huff Creek, Kanawha, Liberty, Logan, McDowell, Mingo, Trinity, Tug River, Upper Ohio Valley, Wayne and Wyoming Quarterly meetings which were presented to this body by letter and proper finance. The ministers, deacons and delegates to be seated to conduct the business of the West Virginia State Association. M & S. Carried.

**Item No. 2.** That a joint meeting with Credential Committee and Business Committee, for the purpose of adopting a resolution to the National Association concerning the wine issue at our Free Will Baptist Bible College. M&S. Carried.

Report of Treasury — Rev. William Smith — M&S to accept report. Carried. Treasurer's report will be listed on separate pages.

Report of Master's Men — by James Vallance. Carl Sullivan is State Senator for Master's Men.

Partial Executive Board Report — by Clerk — The Executive Board met October 2, 1982 at the Mt. Carmel Church and acted upon and made five recommendations.

Item No. 1. We recommend that the pastor of Gilman Bottom, Rev. Joe Osborne, take membership into the Gilman Bottom church, and the church recommend him to the Christian Fellowship Conference, and that he, or church or conference contact the Upper Ohio Valley Conference requesting his letter to unite with the Christian Fellowship Conference. M&S. Carried.

**Item No. 2.** That the paper continue to be printed as it is at this present time by the Gulf Times, at approximately the same cost or less, and with less work. M&S. Carried.

**Item No. 3.** That the printing equipment of the state paper stay as it now is, but if the Christian Education Board decides to use it, they shall be responsible for all maintenance and upkeep. M&S. Carried.

**Item No. 4.** That we accept the Co-op plan of support presented by Rev. William Smith, to send all state money to the state treasury, and the money can either be designated to a specific cause or go into a general fund, to be disbursed by the treasurer to different phases of State or National work. M&S. Carried.

**Item No. 5.** That the \$500.00 given to the State paper from the state treasury as a loan to get them out of the red, be considered as a gift from the State Association. M&S. Carried. M&S to receive items one through five. Carried.

The Executive Board met again Saturday, June 4, 1983, at Central

Church to hear the reports of all standing boards and officers, and to conduct business for the West Virginia State Association.

Rev. William Smith read report of treasury, and the proposed guideline for the Co-Op plan of giving. M&S. Carried.

The treasury report and the co-op plan will be on a separate page. Brother Carl Sullivan gave report of C.E.D. Board and said this board needs a proposed budget of \$6,000.00. M&S. Carried.

Rev. W. C. Combs gave report on state paper, and said this board needs a proposed budget of \$6,500.00. M&S to receive report. Carried.

Others reporting and their reports received were: Rev. Daniel Kelly, Rev. Joe Thomas and Rev. John Henson.

Items of business recommended to the State Association by the Executive Board are as follows:

**Item No. 1.** That each quarterly conference pay the expense of their Executive Board member to State Association, when Executive Board meets on State Association official business. M&S and passed by the State Association.

Item No. 2. That the State Association have the Clerk write letters to the Chairman of each Board of the National Association, requesting a financial breakdown (itemized) of their salary and expenses. M&S and passed by the Association 39 to 21.

**Item No. 3.** That we combine the Foreign and Home Mission Board into one board, and elect a six member board, and this board be called Missions Board, to promote Foreign and Home Missions. M&S was made to table until Saturday's session. Carried.

**Item No. 4.** That we pay the Promotional Director \$75.00 per month and the Treasurer \$25.00 per month from the general fund of the State Treasury. M&S and passed by the State Association.

**Item No. 5.** That we consider combining all treasuries of the State Association together. M&S was made by the State Association to refer this item of business to business committee. Carried.

(Note) The remaining items of the Executive Board report will be picked up this afternoon.

Rev. Carl Lilly gave oral report on Foreign Mission, and Rev. William Smith read a letter from Sister Alice Smith.

West Virginia quota for this year is \$89,000

**Report of State Paper** — by Rev. W. C. Combs. Balance in Bank June 1, 1982 was \$83.73. Received \$5,494.17. Paid out \$5,119.12. Leaving a balance as of June 1, 1983 of \$378.78. During this time 39,397 copies were mailed out at a cost of just under 13 cents per copy. Several hundred were distributed without mailing. The paper needs a budget of \$6,500.00 for the coming year.

Report of Christian Education Board — by Carl Sullivan.

**Bible Institute** — During this past year we conducted three schools with a total of ten classes. The Charleston, Huntington, and Tug River areas have been the most supportive of this ministry.

**Youth Rally** — On November 20, 1982, we conducted our statewide youth rally at Logan High School. This facility was selected because of the large number of churches in the Logan area. Attendance was a bit disappointing. About 100 attended compared to almost 300 at the rally in February, 1982.

**State Youth Competition** — Perhaps our most successful endeavor this year was the youth competition held May 21 in Huntington. The second year of state sponsored competition saw 31 individuals and teams take part. There were 17 individuals and teams in the Bible competition and 14 participants in the music and arts events.

**Proposed Budget** — Ideally this board needs two full-time individuals to conduct these ministries. However, due to the lack of funds this is not possible at the present time. To fund our institute and youth ministries, this needs a budget for the coming year for such items as advertising, postage, mileage, supplies, etc., which totals \$6,000.

Report of Promotional Director — Rev. Billy Samms. I have met three times with Home Mission, twice with Christian Education, twice with Foreign Mission, went to Nashville, Tennessee for leaders conference, and visited fifteen conferences. I am now in the process of organizing a Quarterly Meeting in the Northeastern part of the state. I have traveled 2,700 miles, received \$1,800.00. I have held seven revivals and met with the Executive Committee.

Report of Children's Home — by James Earl Raper, Superintendent.

Contributions to the Children's Home from West Virginia for the past years are as follows: 1978 — \$27,362; 1979 — \$31,905; 1980 — \$29,933; 1981 — \$26,631; and 1982 — \$28,067. —\$3,\$23.800

Reports of Sunday School Training Department and the Women's Auxiliary were given and received as information.

Obituary report was given and all stood in a moment of silent prayer, closed by Rev. T. C. Morgan.

Rev. Herman Hersey gave report on the Board of Retirements.

Final Report of Executive Board.

**Item No. 6.** That the Now Account started by the state treasury to let the interest earned from it stay in treasury, until recommended to do otherwise by State Association. M&S to receive item and passed by State Association.

Item No. 7. Constitution and By-Laws change. That we elect a Moderator for two (2) year terms, and he can serve two (2) terms for a period of four years. M&S to table until Saturday Session. Carried.

**Item No. 8.** That the State Association elect an Audit Committee to audit books each year. M&S was made to refer this item to business committee. Carried.

**Item No. 9.** That we adopt the Co-Op plan of giving proposed by Rev. William Smith, to the Executive Board and the State Association. M&S was made to adopt and passed by State Association. Proposed Co-Op plan listed below:
