We will everywhere hold Christian principle sacred and Christian obligations and enterprises supreme; counting it our chief business in life to extend the influence of Christ in society; constantly praying and toiling that the Kingdom of God may come, and His will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.

To this end we agree to labor for the promotion of educational and denominational enterprises, the support of missions, the success of Sunday Schools, and evangelistic efforts for the salvation of the world. And may the God of peace sanctify us wholly, and preserve us blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

# CONSTITUTION OF THE WEST VIRGINIA STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS

## PREAMBLE

Having received salvation through faith in Jesus Christ, and having been baptized as an outward sign of our separation from the world, and realizing the necessity of being identified with and sharing the fellowship of other believers, have joined ourselves to a local visible church, we do ordain this Constitution to unify the work of Free Will Baptists in the State of West Virginia, and to devise and execute measures for the extension of the Kingdom of Christ and for the salvation of souls in cooperation with the various quarterly or yearly meetings comprising this State Association. May God bless our labor.

## Article No. 1

Section 1. All ordained ministers and deacons belonging to member quarterly meetings and district Associations shall make up the standing delegates to this State Association. Each quarterly meeting shall be permitted to send three lay delegates to the State Association plus one delegate from each Church composing that quarterly meeting.

Section 2. The membership of the State Association shall consist of the quarterly meetings and district Association or yearly meetings from time to time upon approval shall become members of this body.

Section 3. Any minister, deacon or delegate voting in State Association, must be a member of a church in good standing with the quarterly meeting recommending them from the State Association.

Section 4. This State Association shall be affiliated with the National Association of Free Will Baptists of the United States of America, and recognize the Treatise of faith and practice as our guidelines for denominational fellowship, as long as they remain an independent denomination.

## Article No. 2 - Discipline

Section 1. The State Association shall have the right to settle questions of discipline, doctrine or usage that may properly come before it from time to time from any quarterly meetings or yearly meetings composing the said State Association or act upon any appeal that may be made by any of the bodies that belong to the State Association. The said appeal shall have been written and signed by the Association making the appeal then forwarded by mail or in person to State Association and Quarterly Meeting.



Section 2. No quarterly meeting shall license or ordain to preach or to serve as a deacon any man having two living wives. No man having married a divorced woman shall be licensed or ordained to preach, or ordained as a deacon in this State Association.

Section 3. No quarterly meeting shall license or ordain a woman to preach.

Section 4. No quarterly meeting shall be accepted or retained as a member that license or ordain women to preach.

Section 5. The Executive Board shall investigate any charges, after they have been properly presented to the quarterly meeting of which the grieved party or parties are a member. Any charges presented to this State Association Executive Board for consideration must be presented in writing and signed by the person or persons, making the charges.

Section 6. The Executive Board shall be paid the rate of fifteen cents (15¢) per mile from home to destination and return to home when traveling on State Association official business. The party or parties requesting the Executive Board to meet with them, shall be responsible to pay their expenses.

### **Article No. 3**

The officers of the State Association shall be a Moderator and Assistant Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer and Parliamentarian. Each of whom shall be nominated from the floor, at each regular session, except the treasurer, who shall be elected for a three-year period, beginning with the 23rd session, and the Moderator, who will be elected for two year terms, and he can serve two terms for a period of four years, beginning with the 38th session.

Election shall be determined by a majority vote. Those persons and officers thus elected shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and installed.

The Promotional Director shall be employed by the Executive Board subject to approval by the State Association when in session.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside at all meetings to see to it that all the Constitution and By-Laws are obeyed and respected, and to exercise all the right to vote.

The right to vote shall be given the Moderator only in case of a tie. He shall be allowed to speak on any subject provided the assistant is in the chair. It shall be the duty of the Assistant Moderator to assist the Moderator in any way he can in the discharge of his duty. This duty shall not be construed to abridge his right to vote when in the chair, in which he shall be governed to the same rule as that affecting the Moderator.

It shall be the duty of the Clerk to keep a complete record of all meetings to publish in book form, minutes and distributed to various quarterly meetings composing this State Association. All expenses of such records and printing are to be defrayed by the treasury.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to hold and keep all such money as may come into the State Association and disburse it only at the direction of proper authorities. He shall make a bond of not less than all funds coming into his possession. An Assistant Treasurer will be elected to act in any absence of the Treasurer, or act of emergency.

I. Promotional Director - It shall be the duty of the Promotional Director to strive for the enlistment of new conferences and associations into membership of the West Virginia State Association. Also to promote the work of Free Will Baptist in new fields. The office of Promotional Director shall not be used to settle disputes between brethren and conferences. This office shall be supported by the Executive Board or Department.

II. The Executive Committee - The Executive Board shall act as the State Association when State Association is not in session, action subject to approval by State Association.

III. Program Committee - That a program committee be elected on Friday morning to prepare the program for the coming year. This committee shall act as a placement committee and shall comply with the Constitution in making their choice for the Church, where the State Association is to be held. This committee shall consist of two ordained ministers, one deacon, and four members of duly seated delegates. This committee shall prepare to report to the State Association by 1:45 P.M. Saturday afternoon.

IV. The Mission Board - This board is to be a six member board, and shall work to promote Foreign and Home Missions work throughout the State of West Virginia. This board shall cooperate with the Missions board of the National Association, and endeavor to raise funds for the Missions board of our denomination. This board shall arrange missionary conferences throughout the state work as it feels necessary. Also to promote new churches and conferences through the State of West Virginia where we do not have established Free Will Baptist work.

V. Children's Home Board - This board shall maintain a relationship with the Free Will Baptist Home for Children at Greenville, Tennessee, and help provide for its support. The member of this board shall be a trustee of the Board of Trustees of the Free Will Baptist Home for Children at Greenville, Tennessee. Expenses of this trustee shall be



provided for each official visit to the Home. He shall be paid one Hundred Dollars (100.00) per trip, not to exceed three trips a year. This Board shall raise money for and relate its work with a Treasurer, Soliciting Members and Director, and Trustee.

VI. Christian Education Board - This board shall consist of five (5) members elected for a term of five (5) years and elected as so that one member be elected annually. It shall organize within itself a chairman, secretary and treasurer. It shall be the duty of this Board to generally oversee the educational efforts of this Association. This would include but not be limited to (A) organize and conduct a State Bible Institute; (B) Establish Sunday Schools; (C) Promote Church Training Services (CTS) and generally oversee competitive events on the state and district levels.

VII. Publication Board - The Publication Board shall consist of five (5) members elected for a term of five (5) years and elected so that one member is elected annually. It shall be organized with an Editor, Associate Editor, Treasurer and three Associate Editors. It shall be the duty of this board to publish a regular news publication concerning the various ministries of Free Will Baptist in West Virginia and in the world. This board shall be limited to new purchases of \$300.00 per year without approval of the Association or the Executive Board.

VIII. Trustee Board - The duties of this board shall be to hold titles to all real property belonging to this body; the maintenance and upkeep of all such properties; the planning and supervision of all future developments; and the expansion of these properties as directed by the West Virginia State Association.

It is agreed, in this connection, that the Board of Trustees shall at no time sell or encumber these properties by mortgage, lein, or otherwise without the express consent of this body given in regular or called session of this association.

The Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to receive, in behalf of and for the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists, gifts, grants, monies, real estate, or other valuable assets.

The Board of Trustees shall act for and in behalf of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists in any and all transactions involving any of it's properties, but shall do so strictly in accordance with instructions given by said State Association in regular or called session.

In as much as the work of the Publication Board may require an occassional replacement of certain mechanical items, costing more than the present set limit, it shall be the duty of the Board of Trustees to determine the validity of such a need, approve and implement or disapprove the requested purchase at their discretion.

#### Article No. 4 - Executive Board

The Executive Board shall be composed of one ordained minister from each Quarterly Conference that is in good standing with the State Association.

Section 2. If any member of the Executive Board is unable to attend, he must send a proxy in his place.

Section 3. At a regular scheduled session, the Saturday before the State Meeting, this board shall hear the reports of all standing boards and officers. It shall serve as a budget committee and make recommendations as deemed pertinent to State Association.

#### Article No. 5 - Boards

The standing boards shall be the following, Foreign Mission, Home Mission, Children's Home Board, C.T.S. Board, Publication Board and the Board of Trustees.

#### Article No. 6

Annual dues shall be Twenty Five (\$25.00) per each church belonging to Quarterly Meeting that is presented to the State Association.

Section 2. All ministers, deacons and delegates shall pay Five Dollars (\$5.00) registration fee, with the exception of those ministers who are Sixty-Five years old, and older or disabled. One Dollar (\$1.00) to go to the church, Three Dollars (\$3.00) to go to the State Association, and One Dollar (\$1.00) to help pay the annual dues to the National Association.

Section 3. Any minister receiving a good standing card must pay his Five Dollar (\$5.00) registration fee. Each quarterly meeting is requested to collect this fee and send to State Association with their letter.

#### Article No. 7

The State Association shall hold its regular meetings annually on Friday and Saturday before the second Sunday in June at a place and date fixed by the regular session and made known before adjournment.

Special meetings may be called by the Executive Board when extreme necessity demands provided that the clerk of each Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting has been properly notified fifteen days before the date of the meeting of this organization.

Section 2. Any Quarterly Meeting or Church desiring the State Association meet with the body shall present in writing the seating capacity, the facilities for feeding, sleeping and parking.

#### Article No. 8

This Constitution may be revised or changed at any regular session of the West Virginia State Association provided the change is presented in writing and stated one day before vote it taken.



## BY-LAWS

1. A portion of the scripture shall be read and prayer be offered at the beginning of each morning and afternoon session of the State Association and prayer shall be offered at the close of each session.

2. The Moderator or Assistant Moderator shall call the meeting to order at the hour designated by the program committee. When Moderator nor Assistant is present, the Clerk shall call the meeting to order and elect a Moderator-protem.

3. It shall be the duty of the Quarterly Meeting or Yearly Meeting or Association so composing this organization to send a letter to it giving accurately as possible the information requested by the National Association.

4. Not over one deacon shall be appointed on any one committee. Except in case of emergency.

5. Only ordained ministers shall be allowed to moderate this meeting.

6. All Sunday School Conventions and State Women's Auxiliaries Convention report to the State Association, and their report be received as information.

7. In case of controversy regarding parliamentary procedure, Robert's Rules of order shall be considered as final authority.

8. All business except routine shall be brought by committee but should the committee refuse or fail to present to this body any business given it by any member of this State Association, then such business may be discussed unless by vote of this body.

9. No one shall speak for more than five minutes or more than twice on the same subject without the consent of the Moderator.

10. Each conference shall have its letter and finance report sent to the State Association Clerk one week before the State Association convenes.

11. Any member of this body can appeal from the decision of the Moderator to the body and by a two thirds majority of all members present, thereon. This decision shall be sustained or rejected.

12. No one shall leave the body without the consent of the Moderator. Anyone deciding to speak shall arise and say "Brother Moderator" shall not speak further until he or she is recognized by the Moderator. The Moderator shall stop all discussion when not carried on in a Christian Spirit, or think it will lead to discord or division.

13. This State Association shall correspond by messenger or otherwise with other religious bodies.

14. The same person or group of persons shall not serve on more than one standing board or committee as long as it can be supplied otherwise.

15. Not less than three (3) Gospel Sermons shall be preached at any one session of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists.

16. No person shall be elected to any office without being present, except the Executive Board. (The member is recommended by the Quarterly Conference.)

17. The Moderator shall be elected at the close of each two year session on Saturday, and shall serve until his successor is elected at the same time the following two years.

18. No Ministers, Deacons or Delegates shall be permitted to vote that is a known Homosexual, Bi-Sexual or Lesbian in this State Association. The State Association will not retain any person or persons known to be as such.

19. The Officers of the State Association shall receive an honoraria as follows: Moderator - \$35.00. Assistant Moderator - \$15.00. Clerk - \$150.00. Treasurer - \$35.00.

20. The member of the General Board of the National Association shall receive \$250.00 when the National Association convenes East of the Mississippi River and \$350.00 West of the Mississippi River.

21. These By-Laws may be revised or changed at any regular session of the State Association provided that they be plainly written and stated one day before vote is taken.

Minutes of the 40th Annual Session of the West Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists, held at the Parsley Bottom Free Will Baptist Church, June 7, 8, 1985, Lenore, W. Va.

9:30 A.M. - Welcome by Rev. Tommy Street

Moderator - Rev. George Smith took charge.

Motion and second was made to accept program with any necessary changes to be made by the Moderator. Carried.

Credential Committee Report - The Credential Committee made the following recommendations;

Item No. 1. That we accept the letters from Beckley, Brotherhood, Christian Fellowship, Coal River, Elk River, Fayette, Greenbrier County, Greenbrier Nicholas, Guyan Valley, Huff Creek, Kanawha, Liberty, Logan, McDowell, Mingo, Trinity, Tug River, Upper Ohio Valley, Wayne, Wyoming, which were presented to this body by proper finance and delegates. The ministers, deacons and delegates be seated to conduct the business of the West Virginia State Association.

Report of Audit Committee - The Audit Committee reports that all monies taken in and paid out from June 84 to May 85, seem to be in order.

Business Committee Elected - Dr. Lewis Hall, Rev. Daniel Kelly, Rev. Clyde Wood, Rev. G.W. Mounts and Rev. Carl Cooper.

Election of Program and Placement Committee - Rev. Gerald Kelly, Rev. Tom Cox, J.B. Dempsey, Tom Myers, Candy Holstein, Glenna Murphy and Scotty Irvin.

Nominating Committee for the coming year are: Rev. Billy Samms, Rev. Daniel Kelly, and Rev. Carl Vallance.

Nominating Committee filled for today are: Rev. Carl Lilly and Rev. Tommy Street.

Reports were given by Glenna Murphy for Women's Auxiliary, Rev. Dave Franks, for Foreign Mission and Rev. Russell Wright for Home Mission.

Devotional - Rev. Moss Craddock

Singing - by Quartet from Nashville Bible College.

Message - by Rev. Harold Black

Scripture - Galatians 6:11, 17

Text - Verse 14, The meaning of the Cross, the Glory of the Cross.

Representatives from Hillsdale Free Will Baptist Bible College, Edwin Wade, and Randy Cox from Southeastern Free Will Baptist College gave report of their colleges.

### FRIDAY AFTERNOON SESSION

Rev. Ron Scott opened afternoon session with prayer.

Report of Master's Men - Jim Vallance and Carl Sullivan. This year the method of chartering and renewing has changed. Now, when a group joins our organization, that month will be the date for paying dues in continuing years. This department gave the Brazil project over \$8,500 this year. Project Tool shed funds provided a memory typewriter for missionary use in Ivory Coast, Africa. Through the Cooperation plan of giving and the designated and undesignated gifts totaled \$31,376.81.

Our budget for 1984 was \$81,500.00. Receipts totaled \$75,139.48, making it our best financial year.

January 1, 1983 Master's Men owed over \$14,000.00. By December 31, 1983 that debt dropped to just over \$8,000. At the end of December, 1984 this debt was slashed to only \$708. Our 1985 budget total is \$83,321. If divided by the total number of church members in our denomination, each person's share of our budget is only 37 cents. For West Virginia our share is \$4,000.

State Paper Report - by Rev. W.C. Combs. June 1, 1984. Balance \$140.56. Deposits of \$5885.18 plus Petty cash of \$24.54 making at closing balance of \$6050.28. Paid out \$6112.83. Closing balance June 1, 1985, minus \$62.55. Mailed out 52,340 copies at 11.68¢ per copy.

Executive Board Report by Clerk. The Executive Board met November 10, 1984 with the Moderator, Promotional Director, Editor State Paper, Treasurer, Trustee Board, Children's Home Board, Christian Education Board, Master's Men, Missions Board, State Sunday School Convention Board and the Women's Auxiliary Board to hear an information report by all boards.

The proposed budget for this year is as follows:

National Association .....	10%
State Missions .....	50%
State Association General Fund .....	10%
Christian Education Board .....	10%
Children's Home .....	05%
Women's Auxiliary Board .....	2½%
Master's Men .....	2½%

This proposed budget was passed and will take effect beginning January 1985.



Items of business acted upon by the Executive Board are as follows:

Item No. 1. That a typewriter be purchased for the Treasurer of the State Association. M&S. Carried.

Item No. 2. A proposal was made that the State Treasurer pay for the meal today at the Western Steer. M&S. Carried.

Item No. 3. That Rev. John Richmond, Jr. be elected as four year member to the Christian Education Board, to fill vacancy by resignation of Rev. William Smith. M&S. Carried.

Item No. 4. That the Christian Education Board meet with the Sunday School Convention Board, and offer any help or assistance they can. M&S. Carried.

Item No. 5. Moderator made proposal to have a committee consisting of the Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Promotional Director, Treasurer, Clerk, Mission Board Chairman, Christian Education Board Chairman, Editor State Paper, to study the proposal of hiring a full time Promotional Director for the State Association. M&S. Carried.

(Note) This committee met May 17, 1985 at the MacCorkle Church, discussing was held, and learning we were not financially able at this time to hire a full time Promotional Director, will make this recommendation to the Executive Board when they meet before the State Meeting in June and to the State Association when it meets.

The letter from First Altizer Church was read as a point of information not as an item of business. Point of information, that the name of the First Altizer Church not to be used by anyone in any form of competition, at district, state or national.

The Executive Board met again June 1, 1985. Items of business acted upon at this meeting are listed in this the Executive Board report, other items of business discussed will be in the business committee report.

Item No. 1. That Rev. Billy Samms be recommended to serve another year as Promotional Director. M&S. Carried.

Item No. 2. That we sell offset printing and folding machine. M&S. Carried.

Item No. 3. A Treasury report was given and proposed budget was given which will be given in the June session of State Meeting.

Item No. 4. That the Trustee Board be authorized to consult with the proper officials of the Kanawha Conference relative to the Camp Ground at Gold Town, and report to the special committee as previously designated, and this board be authorized to accept this camp ground property as mutually agreed upon or reject it. This item was tabled at the State Meeting.

Item No. 5. That we pay the Promotional Director \$400.00 a month off top of Co-op. M&S. Passed at State Meeting.

Item No. 6. That we pay the State Treasurer \$100.00 a month out of the general fund. M&S. Passed at the State Meeting.

Item No. 7. The interest from the NOW Account be placed in the Contingent account for future use. M&S. Passed at the State Meeting.

Promotional Director's Report - by Rev. Billy Samms. As I present this report to you I am very excited about the work that's being done over our State. I count it a great blessing from God to be able to be a part of this work. Since my last report I have met with the Mission Board three times, met with the Leaders Conference twice. I have also met with the budget committee. Our boards are working more than ever and I praise God for them. I visited all but two of our quarterly meetings this year. Also as Promotional Director I met with the Boone County Conference to try to unite them with our State Association, but to my regret some did not meet the requirements of our State Constitution and By-Laws. Since June of 1984 I have traveled approximately 16,000 miles and received \$3,575 for expenses. I would like to thank the State for the confidence you have placed in me as your Promotional Director. I also put my confidence in our denomination and our state knowing that we will look unto Jesus to lead and direct us in our State Association.

Children's Home Report - State Report by Rev. Joe Thomas.

National Report by Representative James Earl Raper. On May 11, 1985 the Home celebrated its 45th Homecoming Day. Approximately 300 alumni, former employees, and friends of the Home met. We had 3 highschool graduates, and they were awarded their diplomas at the Homecoming Day Service. Contributions from West Virginia for the past five years. 1980 - \$29,933 — 1981 - \$26,631 — 1982 - \$28,067 — 1983 - \$23,800 — 1984 - \$25,015.

Report of Christian Education Board - Stephen Parsons. Bro. Steve reports C.T.S. competition held at the Loudendale Free Will Baptist Church April 26-27, 1985, we had 207 entered in this years competition. Our next date and place for competition will be at the Civic Center, Charleston, W. Va., May 3, 1986. The C.E.D. Board met five times between 10-1-84 and 5-18-85.

Randall House Publications Report - by Bill Foster Field Representative. Bro. Bill mentioned the Church Directory may now be ordered at the price of \$5.95. The new Spanish curriculum was introduced and Dept. Bro. Bill spoke about different things available through Randall House Publications. Also there was a table set up for free items and for sale.

Report on Missions - by Rev. J.L. Varney. The Trinity Free Will Baptist Church gave the most for the National Home Missions Day. This Church was awarded a plaque for giving \$1700.00 on this day. The Foreign Missions Day was not as successful and we came short of the need. Commitment was asked on behalf of the Jim Combs account and not to forget all the other missionaries. Comment was made on the Co-op plan of giving and prayer that it will continue to grow.

Rev. F.A. Giles read letter from sister Alice Smith, missionary from Ivory Coast, Africa.

Report of Obituary - by Candy Holstein - Then moment of silent prayer closed by Rev. Harold Blankenship.

A plaque of honor and recognition was given to the family of Rev. John Henson in behalf of his dedicated service to Free Will Baptists for over fifty years.

Rev. Frank Parsons from Coal River Conference was elected as their Executive Board member to the State.

Rev. Ernest Vance was elected as Executive Board member to State from the Guyan Valley Conference.

Members elected from other Conferences are: Rev. G.W. Mounts, Tug River; Rev. Donald Ellis, Trinity and Rev. Arlie Joe Ball, Wayne.

Report of Partial business.

Item No. 1. That we prepare letter with proper finance and delegates to National Association. M&S. Passed.

Item No. 2. That the honoraria of the clerk be raised to \$150.00. M&S to table, Constitution change. Carried.

Item No. 3. To change wording of budget committee report on page 26, item VII of the 1984 minutes book to read, "To help underwrite the Promotional Director's expenses." M&S to Table. Carried.

Item No. 4. That we delete the entire section one of Article six and replace with: Annual dues shall be Twenty Five (\$25.00) per each Church belonging to Quarterly Meeting that is presented to the State Association.
