The One Hundred and Thirty Sixth Session of the Western Conference was called to order by the Clerk. The Rev. David Currie, Moderator welcomed the visitors and he gave his Moderator's Address to the conference.

Rev. Barry Stallings welcomed everyone followed by a Hymn of Praise, "His Name is Wonderful". The opening scripture and prayer was given by Rev. Phil Lewis. Rev. David Currie, Moderator recognized our visitors followed by the Moderator's Address. The clerk did the roll call of Ministers and Churches;

There were 37 conference ministers in attendance, 4 visiting ministers serving the Western Conference churches, 6 visitors and 14 delegates.

The Nominating Committee submitted their report (a copy of which is attached)

The Clerk read the minutes from the Executive Committee's Meeting; the minutes were accepted as read. (A copy is attached).

The Treasurer gave his report: Beginning Balance as of 10/21/21: \$2,801.60

Total Deposits for the year: \$6,926.60

Total Disbursements for the year: (\$808.12)

Balance on Hand as of 10/10/22: \$6,118.48

The Treasurer's Report was accepted as read.

Rev. Barry Stallings, Clerk of the Board of Ordination gave his report (a copy is attached)

There was no old business to discuss.

New Business:

It was duly noted by the Ordaining Council that Lewis Godwin has surrendered his credentials this morning prior to the opening session of the Convention. A copy of the Board of Ordination report is attached to these minutes.

A motion was made by the Ordaining Council that 50% of all the 2022 offerings go to training ministerial candidates as well as counseling to our ministers when needed. Motion carried.

A motion was made to form a Youth Board/Committee. Motion carried.

Following a short break the Denominational Ministries gave their individual reports.

Christian Education Ministries: Life Conference was held on March 4th. They sent 16 students to summer camp (both Cragmont and Vandemere. The Sunday School Superintendent of the year was from Bethelem FWB Church and Kevin Blackburn was Teacher of the Year.

University of Mount Olive: They are revamping their ministry programs. They had two revival services and 24 students accepted Christ during these revivals. They have added several new programs to their curriculum: The Nursing Stem Lab Program (they received grant money to help with this program); Flight School (they received FAA certification on June 17th and this will open many doors; the Carl

Lancaster Baseball Training Institute and finally, the Mobile Ag Lab (the ribbon cutting will be October 14th and will be used for promotional and outreach programs.

Free Will Baptist Children's Home: Rev. Richard Cuddington gave the report. They are currently serving approximately 110 children and youth. Their first new cottage has passed final inspecting and they will be moving in about a week. They have baptized 18 children and 11 were able to send 11 children to Cragmont. Friends of the Children Day will be November 5th and Rev. Cuddington they would love to have visitors.

Church Planning and Renewal: They will be having seminar on October 27th at LaGrange FWB Church. It starts at 10:00 AM and lunch will be served. Rev. Al Warrick will be leading the seminar. The CPR ministry has a challenge: that Fuguay-Varina is one of the fastest growing areas and we need a church in that area and we need all of our existing churches to support all of our new churches.

Ministers' Programs: Don Fader has retired and now Dan Taylor is leading these programs. He is the financial advisor and owner of Taylor Wealth Management. He wants to begin Town Hall Meetings to give some basic planning for financial needs that our ministers might face.

Foreign Missions: We currently support churches in Bulgaria, Phillipines and Mexico. Rev. Harold Jones and his wife Sandra have served as the helm of this ministry and they will be stepping down from their duties in January 2023.

The Free Will Baptist Press is doing very well.

Carolina Bible Institute and Seminary: Rev. Norman Gordon of Bahama is serving as President and Rev. Rudy Owens is now serving as Chancellor. CBIS has been in operation for 50 years. A new curriculum course has been added: OFWB History/Doctrine/Church Policy and it is offered on line or in person. The Friendship Banquet will be held at Unity Church in Wilson in November.

Following a short break, an offering was received followed by Special Music by "Junkyard Trio". Rev. Ray Wells introduced Rev. Lloyd Hargis who brought the message "Recognizing God's Call". He said that the church is not a cruise ship with people to serve a lot of people who do nothing. Our churches should be like battleships which everyone participates. His scripture readings came from Rev. 22:17, John 13:35; Matthew 22:14, John 16:8, 1 Peter 2:9-10, Acts 1:1, Mark 1:16-18, Galatians 6:9 and Hebrews 11:6. It was a wonderful and thought provoking message.

The Nominating Committee Report is attached.

The Memorial Committee gave their report and Rev. Bobby Futrell sang a beautiful song in Memory of those that have gone before us.

Our One Hundred and Thirty Seventh Session of the Western Conference will meet on October 12, 2023 and Selma OFWB has graciously offered to be the host church.

There being no further business to attend to, Rev. David Currie gave the Benediction and the meeting was adjourned.

REPORT OF THE WESTERN CONFERENCE BOARD OF ORDINATION

SESSION NUMBER 135 OF THE WESTERN CONFERENCE PLEASANT GROVE OFWB CHURCH OCTOBER 13, 2022

The Western Conference Board of Ordination met (2) times in regular session since the last annual session of the Western Conference, and once for an Ordination service and submits the following report and makes the following recommendations for your approval:

8. License Period:

There is a one-year term on the license to preach the gospel with a five-year maximum on the amount of time allowed to preach under license in preparation for ordination. If at any time the *licensed minister allows the license to lapse*, the entire licensing process must be restarted beginning with the recommendation of the local church to the Board of Ordination.

9. Requirements for Ordination:

We commend to our member churches and to all our licensed ministers the attached *Requirements for Ordination*. This document will serve as a checklist for our licensed ministers as they move toward ordination. This document will also aid our churches in answering initial questions that a candidate might have in regard to the requirements for ordination

10. Conference Attendance:

- A. Any minister (licensed or ordained) holding membership in the Western Conference, who fails to attend the annual session of the Conference for two consecutive years or fails to send a letter showing reasonable excuse for non-attendance, is subject to censure and/or the revocation of his credentials of ordination.
- B. All ministers (licensed or ordained) serving in the Western Conference in any pastoral position are required to register and attend the annual session of the Western Conference. Pastoral positions include but are not limited to pastors, associate pastors, and youth ministers. Failure to attend two consecutive years or failure to send a letter showing reasonable cause for non-attendance will subject the minister to censure and/or the revocation of credentials.

11. Annual Convention Attendance:

Any minister (licensed and ordained) holding membership in the Western Conference is required to register and attend our annual one-day OFWB Convention which meets Wednesday following the second Sunday of May on the campus of the University of Mount Olive. A letter stating reasonable cause will also be accepted in lieu of this requirement. It may be sent to either the Clerk of the Board of Ordination or the Clerk of the Conference (not to the Convention office or the President of the Convention).

12. Ministers Transferring into the Western Conference:

- **A.** From Sister Conferences: These ministers must be cleared with the Western Conference Board of Ordination *prior to assuming* the pastorate to which they are called. This is the responsibility of the church calling the minister; however, the minister should be sure it has been done *prior to* beginning the prospective work. This is a simple procedure designed to protect our churches from harm. Our churches are not independent of the Conference as is true in some other denominations and groups.
- **B.** From other Denominations: For this information you are referred to page 89 of our *Articles of Faith & Principles of Church Government*.

13. The Christian Flag Service for Ministers:

The Board of Ordination will serve as the Conference Christian Flag Committee. Any Minister serving in the Western Conference at the time of his death will be given the Christian Flag Service if the minister has so requested or the family so desires. The flag Will be purchased by the Conference

14. Items for Praise:

- 1. Our newly licensed and ordained ministers
- 2. Our new members by baptism or transfer into the member churches of the Western Conference.

15. Things a Licensed Minister Can and Cannot Do:

- 1. A licensed minister *cannot* be called or hired as pastor (or associate) of any church (we need the cooperation of both our churches and our ministers on this item).
- 2. A licensed minister *can* serve a church on an interim or supply basis under the supervision of his Board of Ordination Advisor or another ordained minister as directed by the Board of Ordination. This service is to be limited to six months in any one church. If the church wishes an extension on the services of the licensed minister, the church must appeal to the Board of Ordination.
- 3. A licensed minister *cannot* administer the ordinances of the Gospel.
- 4. A licensed minister *cannot* perform wedding ceremonies.
- 5. A licensed minister *can* conduct worship services, preach, and teach as the opportunities are afforded to the licensed minister.
- 6. A licensed minister can officiate in a funeral service.
- 7. A Licensed minister *can* be elected to serve as temporary chairman of a business meeting with the exceptions as outlined on pg. 74, paragraph 2 of *The Articles of Faith and Principles of Church Government*.
- 8 A licensed minister *can* vote at the annual conference

16. Recommendations to the Conference:

- 1. That our newly Ordained Minister Rev. Phil Lewis be welcomed into the Conference with the Right Hand of Fellowship by the Moderator and their names be added to the list of duly ordained ministers of the Western Conference by the Conference Clerk, as well as Rev. Jay Summerlin who has transferred into our conference.
- 2. That all our ministers, both ordained and licensed, continue to abide by our current *Ministerial Code of Ethics*.
- 3. That our churches <u>not call</u> ordained or licensed ministers from other denominations to serve as interim or to do supply work. Our churches be reminded of the statement from page 68 of <u>The Articles of Faith and Principles of Church Government for Original Free Will Baptists (Of the English General Baptist Heritage): "The Church shall call its own pastor from among the duly ordained Original Free Will Baptist ministers who are approved by the Conference of which the church is a member, upon such terms as shall be mutually agreeable."</u>
- 4. We request that our ministers inform the board of ordination when they resign from their church. This is so that we can assist our churches in the search process and interim period.
- 5. The Board of Ordination recommends that the Conference strongly encourage all current and future licensed ministers to attend annual workshops conducted by the Western Conference Ordaining Council or in conjunction with workshops of other Ordaining Councils, or other groups within our denomination.
- 6. That this report, in its entirety, be received by the Conference and these recommendations be accepted by the Conference as submitted.
- 7. Board of Ordination recommends in its report to this conference that 50% of all monies received into our Conference go toward ministerial training and counseling.

WESTERN CONFERENCE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MINUTES January 31, 2023 at 3:00 PM

The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Kathryne Parnell, Clerk. Rev. George Futrelle opened with prayer.

Members Present: Rev. George Futrelle, Moderator; Rev. Eric Narron, Vice Moderator, Kathryne Parnell, Clerk, Sherman Dilley, Treasurer and Daniel Lancaster, Member at Large.

The purpose of the meeting is to itemize and discussed the following:

- 1. The 2022 meeting of the Western Conference approved that 50% of the offering for 2022 be allocated to the Ordaining Council for training of ministerial candidates as well as for counseling any ministers in need. Hence, Rev. Dilley had questions as to whether he should open a separate account for those monies earmarked for the Ordaining Council, which is approximately \$3,058.00. It was the thought of the entire council that he should proceed in whatever way he deems easier for him.
- 2. The approval of a recommendation by the Ordaining Council to elect Rev. Todd Sutton to fulfill the vacancy left by the passing of the Rev. Charles L. Renfrow. A motion was made and carried that Rev. Sutton fill the vacancy until October 12th at which time the Ordaining Council will make a motion that he be allowed to fill the vacancy to finish out The Late Rev. Renfrow's timer which will be 2025. A letter will be written to Rev. Ray Wells, Chairman of the Ordaining Council of this decision.
- 3. The next order of service was in reference to the dissolution of Agape Church. A motion was made and it carried that the Executive Committee would accept the dissolution of Agape Church. There are still numerous questions of how to go about disposing of the property. It was decided that we would get together with Church Planting and Renewal, get an attorney involved and we realized that are still too many unanswered situations to come up with a viable plan at this time. This will definitely be discussed at a later date.
- 4. A brief report from the Conference Clerk that she is having difficulty getting the names of the Church Clerks along with their addresses and phone numbers. This is a work in progress and as soon as it has been completed, a copy will be sent to Rev. Gary Hayes, President of the Convention.

There being no further business to attend to at this time, a motion was made to adjuourn. Motion carried and Rev. Eric Narron closed with prayer.
